



1. In October 2014, letters were sent from the Dept. of Health & Human Services, NIH and NIAID to research institutions concerning the pause in gain of function research. The letters referred to in the following posts can be found here:

2. One of those letters was sent to Ms. Sherrie Settle at University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill concerning **Ralph Baric's Grant 5U19AI107810-02**.



3. Grant 5U19AI107810-02 was used by Ralph Baric to create a chimeric infectious enhanced coronavirus pathogen. That is by Baric's own admission. You can view Baric's Grant 5U19AI107810-02 here: <https://reporter.nih.gov/project-details/8687584>

4. The NIAID determined that Grant 5U19AI107810-02 may include Gain of Function (GoF) research that is subject to U.S. Government funding pause issued on October 17, 2014. This is known as the moratorium.

The following specific aims appear to involve research covered under the pause:

Project 1: Role of Uncharacterized Genes in High Pathogenic Human Coronavirus infection – Ralph S. Baric, PhD – Project leader

- Specific Aim 2. Novel functions in virus replication in vitro.
  - Specific Aim 3. Novel functions in virus pathogenesis **in vivo**. [*in vivo* means ‘a living organism’]
5. This specific letter proves that Anthony Fauci lied to Congress in violation of **18 U.S.C. § 1001** and Rand Paul had the ability to do something about it. Fauci committed a felony on the floor of Congress when he lied, and he could have been taken out in cuffs. **Fauci also committed a felony by funding gain of function research during the moratorium on top of his anti-trust violations with regards to patents and is guilty of other crimes.**

### 18 U.S.C. § 1001 – Lying to Congress

This is a final response to your November 4, 2014 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request emailed to the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases FOIA Office. Your requested a “list of the roughly 20 projects stopped as a result of the ‘pause’ on funding certain gain-of-function virology studies that was announced by the Office of Science and Technology and the Department of Health and Human Services in October 2014.” In a November 4, 2014 email to me you amended your request to “copies of any letters sent to investigators (or their institutions) asking them to comply with the funding pause.”

We searched the files of the Division of Extramural Activities and the Division of Intramural Research, National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) for records. That search produced 72 pages responsive to your request. Enclosed please find the following 72 electronic pages:

Dear Ms. Moise:

On October 17, 2014, the US Government issued a Research Funding Pause on selected gain-of-function research on influenza, MERS and SARS viruses (<http://www.phe.gov/s3/dualuse/Documents/gain-of-function.pdf>). The scope of this Research Funding Pause has been defined to include any gain-of-function experiments that may be reasonably anticipated to confer attributes to any influenza, MERS, or SARS viruses such that the virus would have enhanced pathogenicity and/or transmissibility in mammals via the respiratory route. NIAID has interpreted this Research Funding Pause to include efforts to mouse-adapt MERS-CoV to increase pathogenesis in mouse models. The Research Funding Pause does not apply to other work supporting the development of MERS animal models (such as breeding of transgenic mouse lines or characterization of these lines), nor does it apply to the use of naturally occurring MERS-CoV strains in mouse models, unless the experiments are reasonably anticipated to increase transmissibility and/or pathogenicity of the virus.

Contracts are used by the US Government to acquire goods and services for its direct benefit. While this Research Funding Pause is in place, goods and services tied to gain-of-function research on influenza, MERS and SARS are no longer a government requirement. Thus, experiments that fall under the scope of this Research Funding Pause will not be conducted under any NIAID contract. This action is being taken in accordance with FAR 52. 242-15 [Stop Work Order (August 1989 with Alternative I (April 1984) incorporated under Article F.3. of the subject contract.

NIAID has determined that the following projects in your contract, HHSN272201000019I Task Order No. HHSN27200003 (A57), may contain gain-of-function experiments that fall under the Research Funding Pause.

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

**PATHOGENESIS** in the mouse models.” falls under the research moratorium. This was research done at Utah State University to **MAKE CORONAVIRUS MORE PATHOGENIC**.

### Statement on misinformation about NIH support of specific “gain-of-function” research

Based on outbreaks of coronaviruses caused by animal to human transmissions such as in Asia in 2003 that caused [Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome](#) (SARS), and in Saudi Arabia in 2012 that caused [Middle East Respiratory Syndrome](#) (MERS), NIH and the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) have for many years supported grants to learn more about viruses lurking in bats and other mammals that have the potential to spill over to humans and cause widespread disease. However, neither NIH nor NIAID have ever approved any grant that would have supported “[gain-of-function](#)” research on coronaviruses that would have increased their [transmissibility or lethality for humans](#). NIH strongly supports the need for further investigation by the World Health Organization (WHO) into the origins of the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus. Working with a [cross-regional coalition of 13 countries](#), we urge the WHO to begin the second phase of their study without delay.
