

The Organization of Islamic Conference is an alliance of Muslim states whose charter<sup>1</sup> lists the group's goals as to "preserve Islamic spiritual, ethical, social and economic values", "to promote Islamic solidarity among member States", "to endeavour to eliminate racial segregation, discrimination and to eradicate colonialism in all its forms", and to "support of the struggle of the people of Palestine, and help them to regain their rights and liberate their land"; that is, to promote the war of the Palestine Liberation Organization against Israel.

Dr. Abdulaziz Othman Altwajri of Morocco is the director general of the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO), a subsidiary of the Organization of Islamic Conference.

Dr. Abdulaziz Othman Altwajri is on the board of the World Congress of Muslim Philanthropists which uses the slogan "Social Justice".<sup>2</sup> The board also includes Amir Dossal of the Global Partnerships Forum.

Richard Attias is a citizen of Morocco and the director of PublicisLive, a subsidiary of Publicis Groupe.

In the interest of personal profit, a number of individuals and organizations associated with Richard Attias have conspired to commit treason by working as agents of the Islamic states and by using the national security resources of NATO to engage in espionage and racketeering against political opponents of the Islamic states.

These include Lord Mark Malloch Brown, a vice president of the World Economic Forum and the World Bank.

These include George Soros, the former living partner of Mark Malloch Brown and a member of the International Crisis Group.

These include Secretary of State Hillary Clinton whose Clinton Global Initiative was founded by Richard Attias.

These include the TerraMar network of Jeffrey Epstein and Ghislaine Maxwell.

These include Bill Gates who holds the title of Knight Commander of the British Empire<sup>3</sup> and whose Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation operates in concert with Malloch Brown, ONE.org, and Ethan Zuckerman of the Berkman Center for Internet and Society.<sup>4</sup>

Members of the Publicis Group subsidiary Kekst include Maurice Levy, Wolfgang Ischinger of the Munich Security Conference, Nuala O'Connor of the Global Network Initiative, Center for Democracy and Technology and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Goran Persson of the European Council on Tolerance and Reconciliation which is advised by Igor Ivanov of Russia, and Matthew Westerman of Goldman Sachs, HSBC, and Rothschild & Co.

Members of the International Crisis Group include Mark Malloch Brown, George Soros, Frank Giustra, Wolfgang Ischinger, Thomas Pickering of the U.S.-Middle East Project, and Ana Palacio of the European Leadership Network which is advised by Igor Ivanov of Russia.

Members of the United Nations Foundation include Queen Rania of Jordan, Kathy Calvin of the Avaaz network, Ted Turner, and Igor Ivanov of Russia.

The board of the World Economic Forum includes Queen Rania of Jordan, Mark Carney of the Bank of England, Sberbank CEO and former Russian trade minister Herman Gref, Min Zhu of the People's Bank of China and the International Monetary Fund, Jack Ma of Alibaba Group, Angel Gurria of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development, Luis Alberto Moreno of Inter-American Development Bank, Susan Hockfield of Carnegie Corporation and Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute, Peter Maurer of the Red Cross, and Orit Gadiesh of Bain and the Peres Center for Peace.

The World Economic Forum hosts the West Islamic World Dialogue which is led by Saudi Prince Turki bin Faisal al Saud, the former head of Saudi intelligence, and which acts as a propaganda shop for terrorist organizations.<sup>5</sup> Its members include Hady Amr, Thomas Pickering, Muna AbuSulayman, John Esposito of Georgetown University, and Shamil Idriss of Soliya and the U.N. Alliance of Civilizations.

Muna Abusulayman is the representative of Prince Alwaleed bin Talal of Saudi Arabia and a board member of Soliya and Meedan.<sup>6</sup> Muna Abusulayman is the daughter of Abdulhamid Abusulayman of the International Institute of Islamic Thought<sup>7</sup> who called for The Islamization of Knowledge.<sup>8</sup> The International Institute of Islamic Thought is part of the SAAR Network of al-Qaeda financier Sulaiman Abdul Aziz al-Rajhi that was raided by the Customs Department in Operation Green Quest in 2002.<sup>9</sup>

The World Economic Forum hosts Vision 3 whose members include DMI Trust, Ithmaar Bank, Faisal Islamic Bank of Egypt, and the CITIC corporation of China.<sup>10</sup> The DMI Trust, Ithmaar Bank, and Faisal Islamic Bank have been accused of financing international terrorism.<sup>1112</sup>

In 1991 Hassan Turabi of Sudan created an alliance of terrorist organizations called the Popular Arab Islamic conference. The alliance included Abu Sayyaf, Egyptian Islamic Jihad, Ennahda of Tunisia, Hamas, Hezbollah, Palestine Islamic Jihad, the Palestine Liberation Organization, the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP), numerous national branches of the Muslim Brotherhood, and the state sponsorship of Iraq and Iran.<sup>13</sup>

Hamas operates in the United States under the name Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR).<sup>14</sup>

Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine recruiter Shawan Jabarin is the director general of al-Haq.<sup>15</sup> Al-Haq member Fadi Quran is a UN Advocacy Officer and a senior campaigner at Avaaz.<sup>16</sup> Al-Haq director Fateh Azzam is a policy advisor to Al-Shabaka which advises McKinsey, the Ford Foundation, and the International Crisis Group.<sup>17</sup>

Hassan Turabi hired Osama bin Laden to create a money laundering network to finance terrorism after the collapse of BCCI.<sup>18</sup> Having formed this network, Turabi made an alliance with the Royal Institute for International Affairs, also known as Chatham House. The Royal Institute for International Affairs is the parent organization of the Council on Foreign Relations.<sup>19</sup>

As of 2015 the panel of senior advisors to the Royal Institute for International Affairs<sup>20</sup> included Ayman Asfari of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, sponsor of the Asfari Institute for Civil Society whose director is Fateh Azzam of al-Haq;<sup>21</sup> R. Nicholas Burns of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund; Victor Chu of the Atlantic Council; Ian Davis of the US-Qatar Business Council; Seok-Hyun Hong of the Asia Foundation; Nemir Kirdar of Investcorp; Marc Leland of the German Marshall Fund; and Lubna Olayan of Saudi British Bank, among others.

A list of alleged al-Qaeda financiers, dubbed the Golden Chain, was recovered from the offices of Benevolence International in Bosnia.<sup>22</sup> These included several high level employees of Suleiman Abdul Aziz al-Rajhi for whom the SAAR Network was named.

The Golden Chain list included Investcorp co-founder Ahmad Zaki Yamani. Investcorp co-founder Nemir Kirdar was a member of Chatham House and the Qatari project Silatech<sup>23</sup> which is one of two subsidiaries of the UN Alliance of Civilizations, the other being Soliya.<sup>24</sup> Silatech's members include Sir David Bell, a member of the Media Standards Trust of Julia Middleton and Helena Kennedy.

The Golden Chain list included Abdul Latif Jameel group CEO Yousif Jameel. Abdul Latif Jameel is a major donor to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. The MIT Center for Civic Media is led by Ethan Zuckerman. MIT Media Lab director Joichi Ito is an associate of Ethan Zuckerman and Jeffrey Epstein.

The United Kingdom Foreign and Commonwealth Office operates Avaaz as a front for Hamas and presumably other foreign terrorist organizations.<sup>25</sup> Avaaz operates Oxfam, the Service Employees International Union (SEIU), and Global Voices. Other names for Avaaz include B Team, GetUp!, SumOfUs, and Purpose. B Team is led by Kathy Calvin and is sponsored by Sir Richard Branson and the Unilever corporation.

GetUp! executive director Brett Solomon became the campaign director of Avaaz.<sup>26</sup> Brett Solomon is an organizer of RightsCon.<sup>27</sup> RightsCon operates the Tech Against Terrorism program on behalf of the United Nations Counterterrorism Executive Directorate (CTED).<sup>28</sup> The UN CTED promotes “#migration, #diversity, social #inclusion, and the prevention of #xenophobia”<sup>29</sup> at the time of an organized invasion of Europe by the global Muslim Brotherhood. Rightscon is sponsored by the U.S. State Department, the Ford Foundation, the Netherlands, and Sweden.<sup>30</sup>

Attendees of the 2016 Rightscon conference included Richard Arbeiter of Global Affairs Canada and representatives of the Association for Progressive Communications, the Astraea Lesbian Foundation for Justice, the Center for Media Justice, Color of Change, the Electronic Frontier Foundation, Hivos, Google Jigsaw, Meedan, Muslim Advocates, the Iranian front National Iranian American Council, the New America Foundation, and numerous technology companies.

United Nations counterterrorism operations have been run by Saudi Arabia since 2011<sup>31</sup> and are advised by Vladimir Voronkov of Russia<sup>32</sup> and Raffi Gregorian<sup>33</sup>, the son of Vartan Gregorian of the Qatar Foundation International who is the president of the Carnegie Corporation. Members of the board of Carnegie Corporation include Pedro Aspe of Evercore whose former president was Lionel Barber of the Financial Times, Austin Beutner of the Los Angeles Times and the Pacific Council on International Policy, Edward Djerejian of the Qatar Foundation, John DeGioia of Georgetown, Tom Kean of the 9/11 commission, Don Randel of the Arcadia Fund of Baron Jacob Rothschild of England, Janet Robinson of the New York Times, and General Lloyd Austin.

The Pacific Council on International Policy gave a charter membership to Maher Hathout<sup>34</sup> of the Muslim Public Affairs Council who is a supporter of Hassan Turabi.<sup>35</sup> Members of the Pacific Council control the USC Annenberg School of Communication, the Anti-Defamation League, the California Community Foundation, the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences at Stanford University, City National Corporation, the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, the Hamilton Project, the J. Paul Getty Museum, Los Angeles World Airports, the Los Angeles Times and San Diego Union Tribune, Ticketmaster, United Way of Greater Los Angeles, the Screen Actors Guild, and the law firms Gibson Dunn, O'Melveny & Myers, and Skadden Arps.

Pacific Council board member Ernest Wilson is on the boards of the Annenberg Trust, the Global Network Initiative, Demand Media, and the Democracy Fund of Pierre Omidyar who runs a spy ring called the Omidyar Network that works for the Global Impact Investing Network of Sir Ronald Cohen. Members of the Democracy Fund include Sonal Shah of Sir Ronald Cohen's Social Finance network and Juleanna Glover of the British spy ring Teneo whose CEO Nick Claydon is a trustee of Demos, the main organ of the British Communist Party. The founders of Demos include Marxism Today founder Julia Middleton, Geoff Mulgan of Labs for Systems Change, Ian Hargreaves of the Media Standards Trust, and Stephen Heintz of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund.

Helene Gayle of the Rockefeller Foundation is part of the McKinsey Social Initiative which promotes the Purpose network. Other members include Lubna Olayan of Saudi British Bank, Mona Mourshed of the Qatar Foundation and New America, Dominic Barton of the Inclusive Capitalism project of E.L. Rothschild and the City of London, and Phumzile Mlambo-Ngcuka of the African National Congress and UN Women. Under the direction of Mlambo-Ngcuka, the United Nations fabricated a narrative of "cyber violence"<sup>36</sup> to create a justification for governments to censor the Internet.

The TerraMar network<sup>37</sup> includes Lord Peter Mandelson, Sir Richard Branson, Sir David Tang, Ghislaine Maxwell, Jeffrey Epstein, Richard Attias, Amir Dossal and Inge Solheim of the UN Office of Partnerships, Barry Diller of InterActiveCorp, Nick Pritzker, Richard Rockefeller, David de Rothschild, Jonathan Soros, David Wassong of Soros Fund Management, Ahmet Oren of Turkey, Susan Avery and Catriona Munro of Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute, Edie Lutnick of Cantor Fitzgerald, and Mortimer Sackler of Purdue Pharma, the maker of OxyContin.

Secretary of State Hillary Clinton gave control of the State Department Bureau of Near Eastern Affairs to Alex Djerassi, a nephew of Ghislaine Maxwell.<sup>38</sup> Clinton's daughter Chelsea Clinton was given a job with InterActiveCorp.

The Bridgespan Group is sponsored by the Omidyar Network and the William and Flora Hewlett Foundation. Its members include Thomas Tierney and Robert Bechek of Bain, Linda Hill of State Street and the Rockefeller Foundation, Stephen Ellis of TPG, and Fay Twersky of the Rothschild Foundation and Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. Brian Trelstad of the Bridgespan Group and the Acumen Fund is a partner in Bridges Ventures with Sir Ronald Cohen.

TPG operates the Rise Fund with Jeff Skoll, Pierre Omidyar, Sir Richard Branson, Reid Hoffman, Paul Polman, and William McGlashan of Creative Artists Agency. TPG CEO David Bonderman is a partner in the Russian Direct Investment Fund. Paul Polman is a member of Inclusive Capitalism and the CEO of Unilever which hosts the Avaaz network in its corporate headquarters. McGlashan is a business partner in the Endeavor group of Edgar Bronfman Jr., Reid Hoffman, Matthew Bannick of the Omidyar Network, Jason Green of the National Venture Capital Association, Nick Beim of the CFR, and Fadi Ghandour of MIT Media Lab.

Other partners of the Russian Direct Investment Fund include Stephen Schwarzman of Blackstone Group. Schwarzman is also a member of the US-China Strong Foundation, the Asia Society, the Atlantic Council, and the 21st Century Council of the Berggruen Institute.

Alfa Group is part of the Russian International Affairs Council with direct links to the Russian ministries of defense, culture, foreign affairs, education, and economic development.<sup>39</sup> The Alfa Group includes Russian billionaires Mikhail Fridman, German Khan, Alexei Kuzmichev (sometimes spelled Kousmichoff), Leonard Blavatnik, Viktor Vekselberg, with a combined net worth of over \$50 billion.<sup>40</sup> The Blavatnik Family Foundation, the Ford Foundation, and the Rockefeller Foundation are partners of the Inclusive Capitalism project.<sup>41</sup> Leonard Blavatnik financed the Blavatnik School of Government at Oxford University whose international advisory board includes Bill Clinton, Bank of England governor Mark Carney, and Google CEO Eric Schmidt,<sup>42</sup> and whose "distinguished practitioners" included Lord Mark Malloch Brown.<sup>43</sup> Leonard Blavatnik was knighted by Queen Elizabeth for "services to philanthropy."<sup>44</sup>

Google is a federal contractor whose subsidiary Google Ideas (now Google Jigsaw) participated in the overthrow of the Ukraine, Egypt, and Syria,<sup>45</sup> which led to the Zawahiri network and ISIS controlling much of Egypt and Syria. Google Jigsaw employees include Anita Sarkeesian, Zoe Quinn, Randi Harper, Rose Eveleth of the Shirtgate incident, and Jamia Wilson of Women, Action, and the Media (WAM).<sup>46</sup>

WAM board member Deanna Zandt is one of numerous members of the Applied Research Center (ARC) which works in concert with Color of Change to radicalize the American black community.<sup>47</sup> ARC newsletter Colorlines ran a promotional obituary for Maher Hathout of MPAC.<sup>48</sup> Color of Change is a project of Julia Middleton's Demos network which is run from Whitehall by British intelligence.<sup>49</sup>

Google Ideas director Jared Cohen is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations,<sup>50</sup> a subsidiary of the British Crown's Royal Institute for International Affairs. In 2015 Forbes reported that Google veterans (probable British agents) controlled the communications of Facebook, Twitter, Tesla, Square, Yahoo, Lyft, Uber, Pinterest, Snapchat, Sequoia Capital, and Accel Partners.<sup>51</sup>

Google's partners include the Institute for Strategic Dialogue whose former president George Weidenfeld was a member of the Blavatnik School of Government with Eric Schmidt, Bill Clinton, and Mark Malloch Brown. The Institute for Strategic Dialogue has undergone a complete change in personnel with the new membership composed of European Muslim Women of Influence, Revolution Muslim, and the UN Alliance of Civilizations. This group also uses the name Strong Cities Network.
