

PREAMBLE:

America was built on a promise. The promise that if you work hard, you can get ahead. The promise that your children will have more than you did. The promise that no one—not the rich, not the powerful, not those with friends in high places—is above the law.

For too many families, that promise has been broken. Bank fees eat your paycheck while Wall Street bonuses hit record highs. Toxic chemicals in your child's cereal are banned everywhere else. Student debt follows you to the grave. A full week's work leaves you in poverty. And in too many cities, the water from your tap poisons your own children.

Worst of all, when the powerful break the law, they don't go to jail—they go to dinner

parties. When victims cry out for justice, their voices are buried in sealed records and classified files. When whistleblowers try to tell the truth, they are silenced, surveilled, and destroyed.

The American Promise changes all of it. It puts 4% interest in your pocket through postal banking—free from fees, free from Wall Street greed. It gets Red 40 and Yellow 5 out of your child's cereal. It wipes out student debt and makes college free. It raises the minimum wage to \$25 and gives you a 32-hour work week. It replaces every lead pipe in America and bans forever chemicals.

This is not a Democratic bill or a Republican bill. It is a people's bill. It is a promise kept.
