HOW TO HEAR 2000 FLUSHES PIRATE RADIO:

This 1s <u>PIRATE</u> radio, it a ILLEGAL, and because of that it takes a small, but we hope worthwhite effort on your part to hear our broadcasts. If we were to boost our power levels and build a commercial-style broadcast lower, it would be much easier for federal authorities to find us and shall us cown, and that wouldn't be much fun for you, the listent. Se here are a few guide lines to help you tune in to the action.

1. You have to be within our broadcast range, which is basicly everywhere on the map below.

2. Newer FM receivers get the best reception. If you have one, a digital reciever with manual much-button tuning is best, Seny, Technica, and Pioneer all make good quellty home, suts and gheits blaster style reviewers. Most older non-digital receivers will must fine but the newer digital tuners are sensitive enough to pick up as little as 001 millivolts-per-meter of reduce frequency power--in real world iteras, that's pretty dang sensitive. Walkann or clock-reducitype receivers are usually nor too sensitive. Walkann or

3. Make sure you have e good entenns. The factory stock anienns that comes with year radio is fine, even your cer radio entenns should be great just as it is. But if you've lost your entenns you should try and get a repiscement episce of write, a cost thanper, the tim fell left over from your tuns fish annewich. ANYTHING is better than no antenns at all. Your unfriendly lacel Radio Sheek cerries a number of decent antennes, the best ones are #15.2164... a pood, cheep rooftop model, end 5.1823, a intenhenalve indoor home aftero model. All off you're on the edge of our broadcast range. Radio Sheek's #15.1833, is a cheap, amplified indoor entennis which will help to again the reception.



4. Get your radio and anienns as high up as possible. You should at least be et aireet level, you'll get the worst reception in a basement, but you'll est the best teception on an upper fisce of if you have one, a reof top antenna although somewhere in the middle should be just fine.

5. If you plan on listening in yout carstay away from busy commercial attents you'll get a lot of interfetence in there areas. Residential attents are best, or recent test breadcest we found god reception throughout most residential areas of South Minnespolis with the east reception in the Sewaid, Longfellow and Pawderhorn neighborhoods. - 2000 Flushes? What's That! Isn't that some toilet bowl cleaner? A: Yup, Al fissen invented it. It also happens to be the name of our pirate radio station.
- - Q: What frequiry is it? A: 99.3 FM
- Q: When should I listen to it?
- A: 2000 Flushes Pirate Radio will be broadcast every wednesday night from 9 PM until whenever we're ready for bed. Drive, hitch, or otherwise motivate yourself into the broadcast range (as shown on the preceding page).
- Q: You mean I can't hear it at home in Eden Pratie? Burnsville? <Insert Your City Here>?
- A: This is PIRATE radio. By listening to 2000 Flushes, you are committing a revolutionary act: You are withdrawing yourself as their product. 2000 Flushes Pirate Radio has no spousors to kiss up to, no adverts to brainwash you, and no lies. Not one, Just 100% Pure Pirate Radio.


THE REVOULTION STARTS WITH YOU...

WHY PIRATE RADIO?

Few things expose the sham that is the Amerikan government like our national broadcasting policies do. With television and radio station licenses costing upwards of \$100,000 the FCC has insured that OUR mass media is nothing more than the radio spectrum real estate of the largest corporations. Did you know that under 15 corporations own nearly 70% of the worlds media? While the do-it-yourself media is growing, we believe the mass media serves an important social role and that it should be owned and accessible to all people. While the present media structures' programming is usually base, nacoticizing, and demeaning to women, non-whites, and the poor, few can deny the potential of the mass media to create a common cultural heritage with the power to unify rather than divide us.

Many municipalities require cable companies operating in their city to provide public access, and we think the same should be the case for the broadcast

media as well.

This however isn't likely to happen, which is why we support an all out attack of MEDIA PIRACY. The FCC claims there simply isn't enough radio spectrum to grant broadcast licences to every community organization that wants one -- this is a lie. If boring bloated old rich guy owned stations like KORS weren't allowed to broadcast at power levels up in the Megawatt range, causing their signal to bleed up and down the FM band it would free up enough spectrum for every neighborhood to have its own community radio station and still leave enough spectrum for larger media providers to exist on a reduced level, this is infact already the media structure in some other countries: Italy for example. Such a move however we mean a huge loss in licenceing fees for the FCC -- its a classic case of policy makers creating financialy profitable regulations for themselves.

The FCC also claims that deregulation of the radio spectrum would result in massive radio interference, this is yet another lie on their part, it is a matter of elementry electronics technology to broadcast a clean radio signal that doesn't interfer with other services, we know--

WE'RE DOING IT.

Our government has shown that it doesn't respect the sovereignty of other countries by polluting their airspace with government funded pirate stations like Voice of Amerika and Radio and TV Marti, so why should we respect our own governments broadcast regulations.
