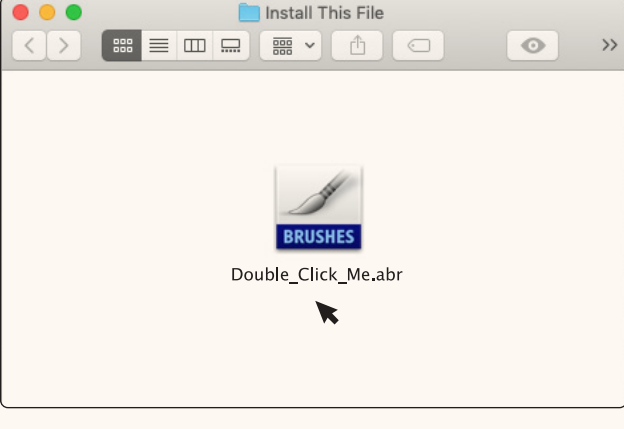

Quick Install:

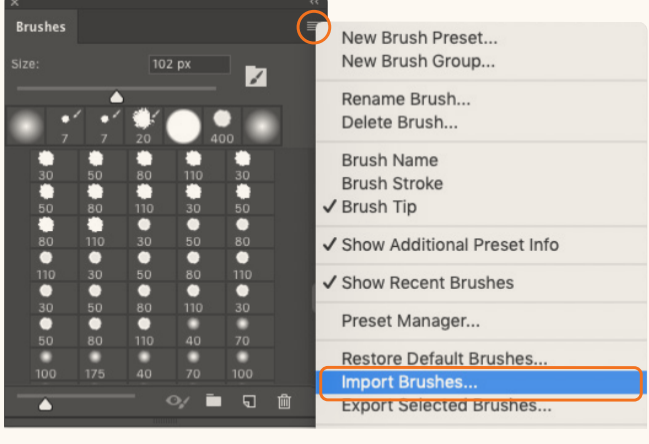
1. Open Photoshop.
2. Locate the .abr brush preset file in the folder titled 'Install This File'.
3. Double click the .abr file to automatically install it into Photoshop.
4. The brushes will appear in the Brushes panel whenever the Brush Tool is selected.



Or

Manual Install: (use if Quick Install fails)

1. Open Photoshop.
2. Open the Brushes Panel Window > Brushes (or Window > Brush Presets in older PS versions) and click the fly-out menu in the top right corner.
3. Select Import Brushes... then locate the .abr file in the 'Install These Files' folder and click Open to install.
4. The brushes will appear in your Brushes Panel whenever the Brush Tool is selected.



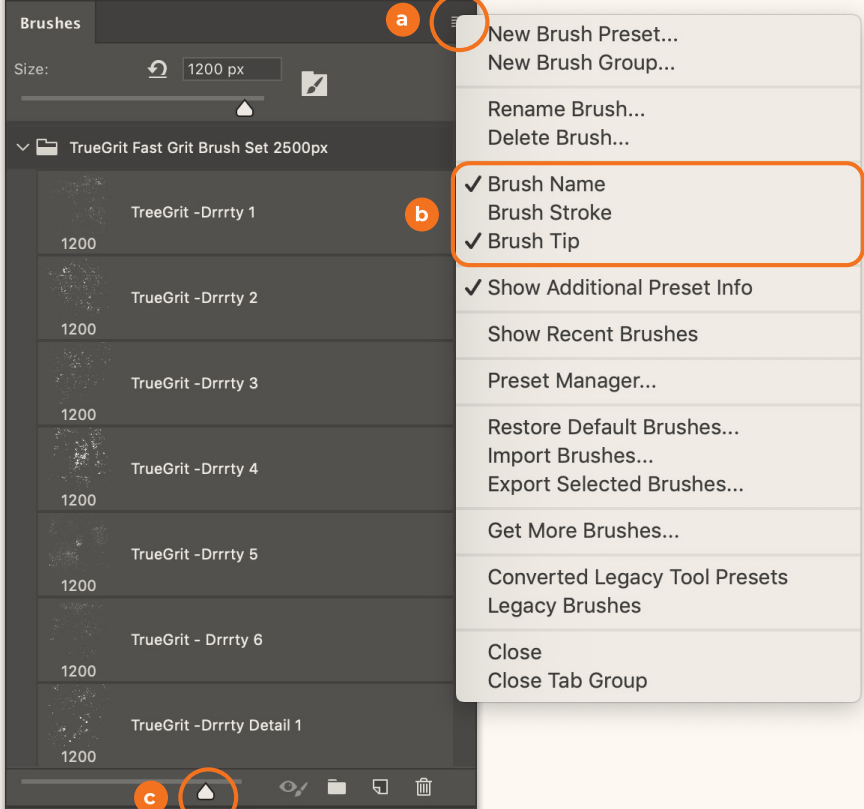
GETTING TO KNOW YOUR BRUSHES

SET YOUR BRUSHES PANEL TO DISPLAY BOTH THE BRUSH NAME AND THE BRUSH TIP

This makes it super-easy to select
brushes by name (see below) or
thumbnail at a glance.

In your **Brushes Panel** (Window > Brushes) click the fly-out menu on the top right side of the panel (a) and choose **Brush Name** and **Brush Tip** (b).

You can also adjust the size of
your brush preview using the
scale slider at the bottom of
the Brushes Panel (c).

Each brush has a few naming conventions that
will help you select the right brush for the job.

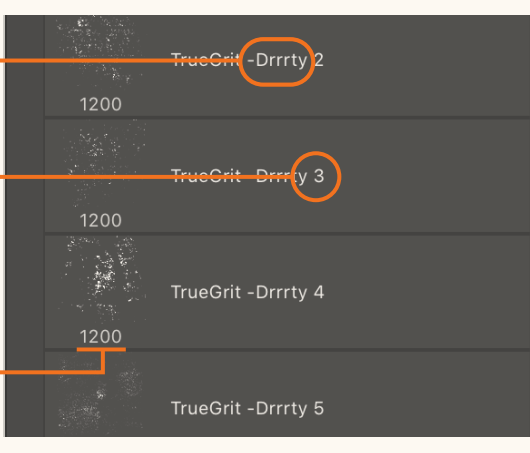

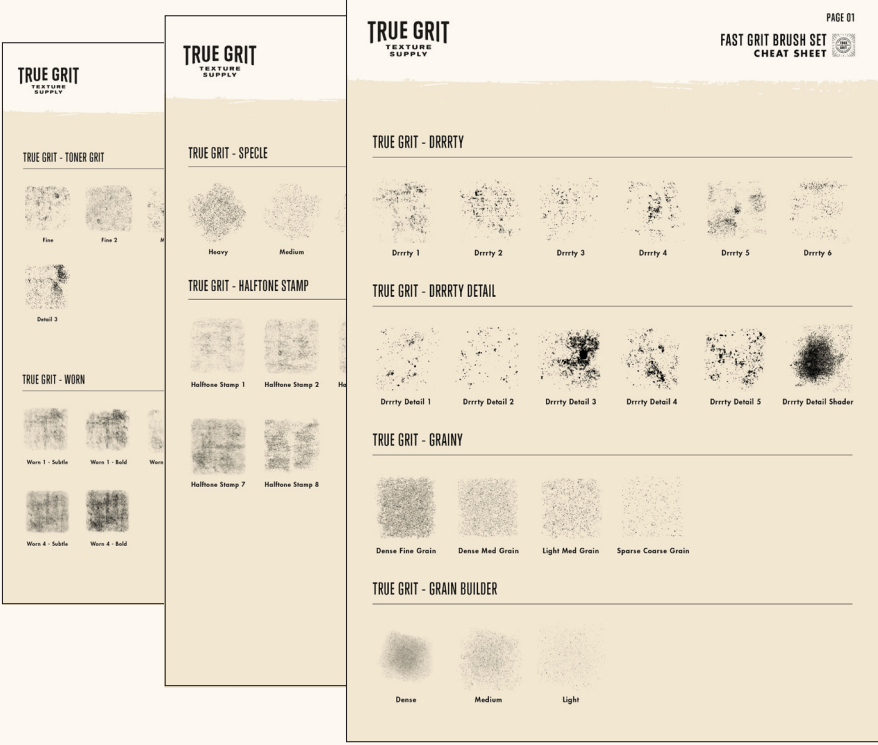

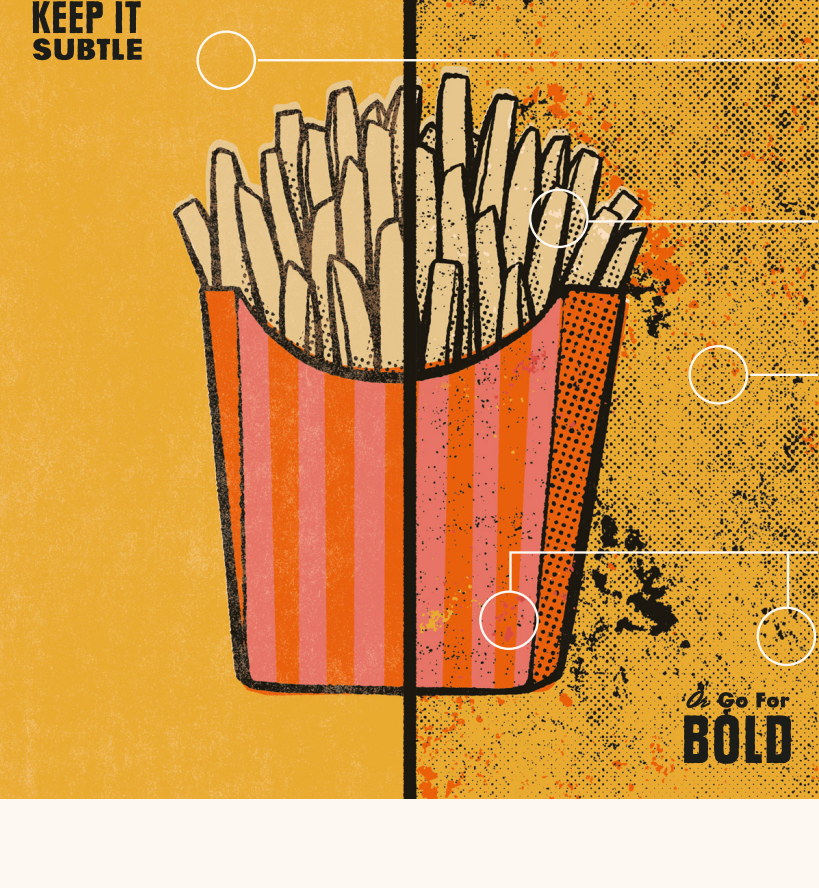


GENERAL TIPS AND TRICKS

Just point and click.

With the exception of a small number of brushes, the Fast Grit brush set has been designed to be used in a 'point and click' manner. Just point the brush where you want the texture to go, click and you're done. There's no hard edges or obvious crops, making it fast and easy to repeat brushes without any visible seams

Here's some general tips, tricks and suggestions for getting the most out of your Fast Grit Brushes.



Try using a light foreground
colour with transparency to
create subtle worn effects.

Try masking brushes into specific
areas rather than letting them
run free

Halftone brushes work great as
background texture or masked into
specific areas of your artwork

Try experimenting with specific
colors from your artwork to create
multiple levels of texture.
