



Executive Summary








History of the Bible


- God's divinely inspired Holy Word is the sword of the Spirit
- It has been translated and handed down faithfully for centuries
- The power, the truth and the authority of God has been preserved
- The King James version of 1611 is the gold standard for bible translations.
- Brooke Foss Westcott (1825–1901) and Fenton John Anthony Hort (1828–1892) headed up an effort in the late-1800's to re-translate the bible using the Alexandria manuscripts (instead of the Antioch manuscripts that had been used for centuries)
- Their translation is the foundation for the NIV, ESV, ASV, NKJV, JW and many other popular modern day translations that we see used today (see Slides 8 - 10 for some additional information on the history).








Westcott and Hort


- Westcott was a bishop in the Anglican church and Hort was a Professor of divinity but both men had abandoned their Christian faith.
- Westcott formed a club at Cambridge called Hermes. The club was well known for homosexual activity between its members.³
- Both men were devoted occultists. In 1851, Hort and Westcott started the Ghost Society which over the years included some of the most noted intellectuals in England including future Prime Minister Arthur Balfour.⁴ Balfour was at the center of an elite group which had inherited great political power, wealth and social position.⁵ They were leaders in the occult revival of the 19th century and founders of the New Age Movement with Luciferian Helen Blatavsky.⁶

Westcott and Hort

- Hort and Westcott were committed Communists.⁷ They hated America and democracy.⁸ There was a close tie between their occult group and Marxism in England.⁹ And under the leadership of the powerful Arthur Balfour they began working on what has become the one world religion and the New World Order.¹⁰
- A key strategy in bringing about this one world religion involved replacing the King James Version which was the standard in their day with a revised text where words were added and removed and meanings changed.¹¹ Hort and Westcott's New Age Versions have virtually replaced the King James version today.





Westcott and Hort


- Fully steeped in the Alexandrian philosophy that "there is no perfect Bible", they had a vicious distaste for the King James Bible and its Antiochian Greek text, the Textus Receptus.¹²
- They did not believe that one could attain Heaven by either works or faith, since both believed that Heaven existed only in the mind of man.
- Both believed it possible to communicate with the dead and made many attempts to do that through their society they called "The Ghostly Guild."
- Hort was an admirer and proponent of Darwin and his theory of evolution.
- They guided the Revision Committee of 1871-1881 away from God's Antiochian text and toward the corrupted Alexandria text .
- These two apostates left a legacy of heresy in their corrupted translation of 1881. Sadly, their translation has become the foundation for all future bible translations including, ASV, ESV, NIV, NKJV, NASV, JW and many others.

*¹⁶ For God so loved the world, that he gave his only **begotten** Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (KJV)*

“For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God” Romans 8:14

Therefore, God has many sons but only One **begotten** Son.




“omnipotent” is missing from Revelation 19:6

Reduced from infinite power to merely almighty




“Godhead” is missing from Colossians 2:9

true and full power of God in Jesus. But why?




“sodomites and abominations” are missing from 1 Kings 14:24

*24 And there were also **sodomites** in the land: and they did according to all the **abominations** of the nations which the LORD cast out before the children of Israel. (KJV)*

[2 Kings 23:7](#) And he brake down the houses of the **sodomites**, that were by the house of the LORD, where the women wove hangings for the grove.


Why have the apostate translations eliminated the word “sodomite”? Check your bible – it’s gone.



What are the new translations doing to God's Holy Word?


- Diminishing the Divine Nature of God and His power

They have willfully contaminated the Word of God to serve their master, satan and to damage our relationship with God.






God loves us, He is not the author of confusion


Don't perpetuate satan's deception in your church

LIE #3: Older and more reliable manuscripts have been discovered since the King James Bible.


Truth: Dr. Sam Gipp writes, "The fact is, that the King James translators **had all of the readings available** to them that modern critics have available to them today." ²

LIE #4: The NIV is more accurate.








God's words are pure and must be preserved
