The Pacific Region kicks off a year of celebration walks for AVA's 50th Anniversary January 9-11, 2026 in Boulder City, NV. Sponsored by the Las Vegas High Rollers & Strollers and hosted by the AVA Chairman, this weekend offers a mix of self-guided and group walks as well as two special social gatherings.



Boulder City, 20 miles south of Las Vegas, is the only incorporated city in Nevada without gaming and home of the State's number one tourist attraction, Hoover Dam. 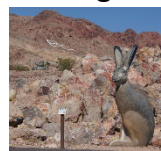
Historic Railroad Tunnels Trail, Sanction #130265 *designated group walk January 9, 9AM*



The Old Historic Railroad Tunnel trail in the Lake Mead National Recreation Area is a step back in time to related to the construction of Hoover Dam and how building materials were brought to it in the 1930's. This gravel and dirt trail brings you through five mountain tunnels where the old railroad track used to be in place and delivered materials for the dam construction. You also get great panoramic views of Lake Mead and its mountain setting. Collect a stamp for your National Parks Passport at the Lake Mead Visitor Center. Strollers and wheelchairs may find the trail, while level, a little challenging.

Bootleg Canyon, Sanction #130264

designated group walk January 10, 9AM



Get up close and personal with some giant animals at Bootleg Canyon Park. Then continue on the wide paved path of the River Mountain Loop Trail with rolling hills and magnificent views. Turn onto the wide sidewalks of Boulder City Parkway with several food places including The Patio at Chilly Jilly's (GREAT for Breakfast or Lunch with fire pit tables). Then head back up to the park passing the Nevada State Railroad Museum and the home of Fisher Space Pens.

Veterans Memorial Park, Sanction #130036/Y2830 *designated group walk January 11, 9AM*



Walk begins in beautiful 25-acre Veterans Memorial Park famous for 4th of July celebrations. You will also walk through the Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery (No Pets allowed!). The Boulder City Municipal Airport is adjacent to cemetery. There are no commercial passenger carriers but tour operations and private aviation make it the 3rd busiest airport in Nevada. Most paths are paved but there are segments of natural and gravel surfaces which might be more challenging for wheelchairs or strollers.

While the three walks have designated group walk times, you may choose to complete them on your own any of the three event days. They are the only walks offered for pre-registration. These two additional self-guided walks will also be available for on-site registration in the Hospitality Room at \$4 per person. You may complete them at your leisure during daylight hours.

Boulder City Historic Downtown, Sanction #130034/Y1880



The first part of the walk goes thru downtown and the original residential areas. Many homes date from the 1930s. Some are in near-original condition; some have been renovated. Restaurants and gift shops are plentiful along Nevada Way. Look for outdoor sculptures along the route. The 10K walk goes to the Nevada State Railroad Museum, with static exhibits and a model railroad museum.

Hoover Dam, Sanction #130035/Y1809



Hoover Dam access during daylight hours only and subject to security screening. Please carry water on this walk. This 5K trail crosses the Mike O'Callaghan-Pat Tillman Memorial Bridge and Hoover Dam. 10K includes two of historic railroad tunnels trail (gravel). The contrast between lake and desert is breathtaking.

BEST DAM WINE WALK SATURDAY JANUARY 10, 2026, APPROX. 4PM TO 8PM

NOTE: This event is organized by the Boulder City Chamber of Commerce, not AVA or Las Vegas High Rollers & Strollers. The Chamber is offering our group a special rate of \$15 (savings of \$10) with check-in at the Best Western Hotel so you don't have to stand in line at the regular check-in location. IF you don't wish to participate you can still visit the shops without a wristband.



Boulder City's Historic District transforms into a lively gathering space where locals and visitors alike come together to explore charming shops, enjoy wine (maybe sangria), and meet new friends. With a minimum of 25 participating businesses each month, this experience is the perfect blend of socializing, shopping, and supporting our historic community.

Upon check-in, each guest will receive a complimentary souvenir Tossware cup (100% recyclable), a wristband to wear throughout the event, and a detailed map of all participating locations. Once checked in, you're free to explore Boulder City's Historic District, visiting local shops and tasting wine until at least 7:30 PM. The January theme is Sports Teams so you're your AVA and Club items to celebrate OUR Sport! While wine walk is not a sanctioned AVA event it does cover a significant 5K portion of our Historic Downtown YRE if you visit all the locations. You may register for the YRE (\$4) at the hotel if you desire IVV credit with your wine.

INDIVIDUAL WALKER PRE-REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Each participant must:

- Pre-register by filling out the PRE-REGISTRATION FORM, which includes signing the insurance liability waiver.
- \$10.00/participant Registration Fee is required of **all** participants.
- \$4.00/walk participant fee to do each walk, with or without receiving IVV Credit.
- If attending the Welcome Dinner, include \$35 per person which includes tax and tip. Will be refunded on-site if received after restaurant capacity is reached.
- If participating in the Best Dam Walk operated by the Boulder City Chamber of Commerce, include \$15 per person, *21 and over only*.

- Check and Walk Registration Form(s) **MUST** be received by December 10, 2025

Pre-register for the walks by December 10, 2025, because:

- Less time and staffing required for each event
- More accurate estimates of event attendance/logistics
- Reduction in event expenses by defraying onsite printing charges
- Greater flexibility and choice in some start/finish times

Walk directions/maps will be e-mailed to registered participants in December. Please print these documents and bring them with you to the event. Swag Bags with name badges, dinner tickets, local attractions, and more can be collected at our Best Western Hospitality Room.

The Hospitality Room will be the check-in and stamping for all events. Hours of operation will be determined closer to the event. "Drop-ins" who have not previously registered for the weekend should check in here. Volunteer staff will be available to answer questions during posted hours. POC phone number will be provided on-site for after-hours assistance. NOTE: For walkers who have not pre-registered a small supply of walk directions will be available, while walk participant fees should be paid in the Hospitality Room. All participants, including "drop-ins," are required to pay the Registration Fee (\$10) per person.

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT HOTEL

From Las Vegas take I-11/US 93 south to Boulder City Parkway, Exit 15B. At second light continue straight (name changes to Nevada Way). Best Western is on left about 3 blocks, just past 5th Street. If coming from Arizona, take Exit 2 to stop light, then left on Nevada Way.
