All four immediately got out the house, back into the van, and the hell out of there before the police came.

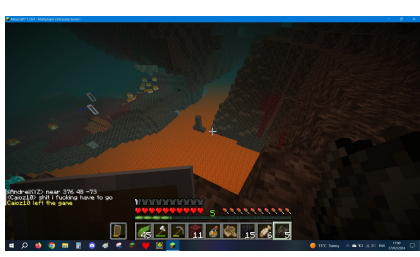
And now, the Laserlime paster was dead.

LEMURIA FINALLY UPGRADES SCRIBUS

After spending a fair amount of time struggling, Lemuria is happy to report that he has now upgraded to Scribus 1.6.1, with which this issue was made.

As background information, Scribus is a free and open-source desktop publishing software program, essentially an alternative to Adobe's InDesign. Lemuria is broke like all of us and unwilling to pay for InDesign, so instead, he's decided to go with Scribus.

Something in his terminal configuration was preventing him from running the AppImage due to Qt's (Qt is a GUI library needed by Scribus to run) inability to load the CORRECT libraries

(it tried to load libraries from the system, not the AppImage itself, Lemuria speculates).

With technical issues out of the way, at least for now, Lemuria will continue his mission to inform the OWOT community through his newspaper. Thank you for reading and supporting the paper in its first week.

And he'll continue to pore over his configuration and take a long hard look (thankfully he's already received answers from the helpful people of the Scribus forum), trying to get to the bottom of it all.

A Review of FineFine City

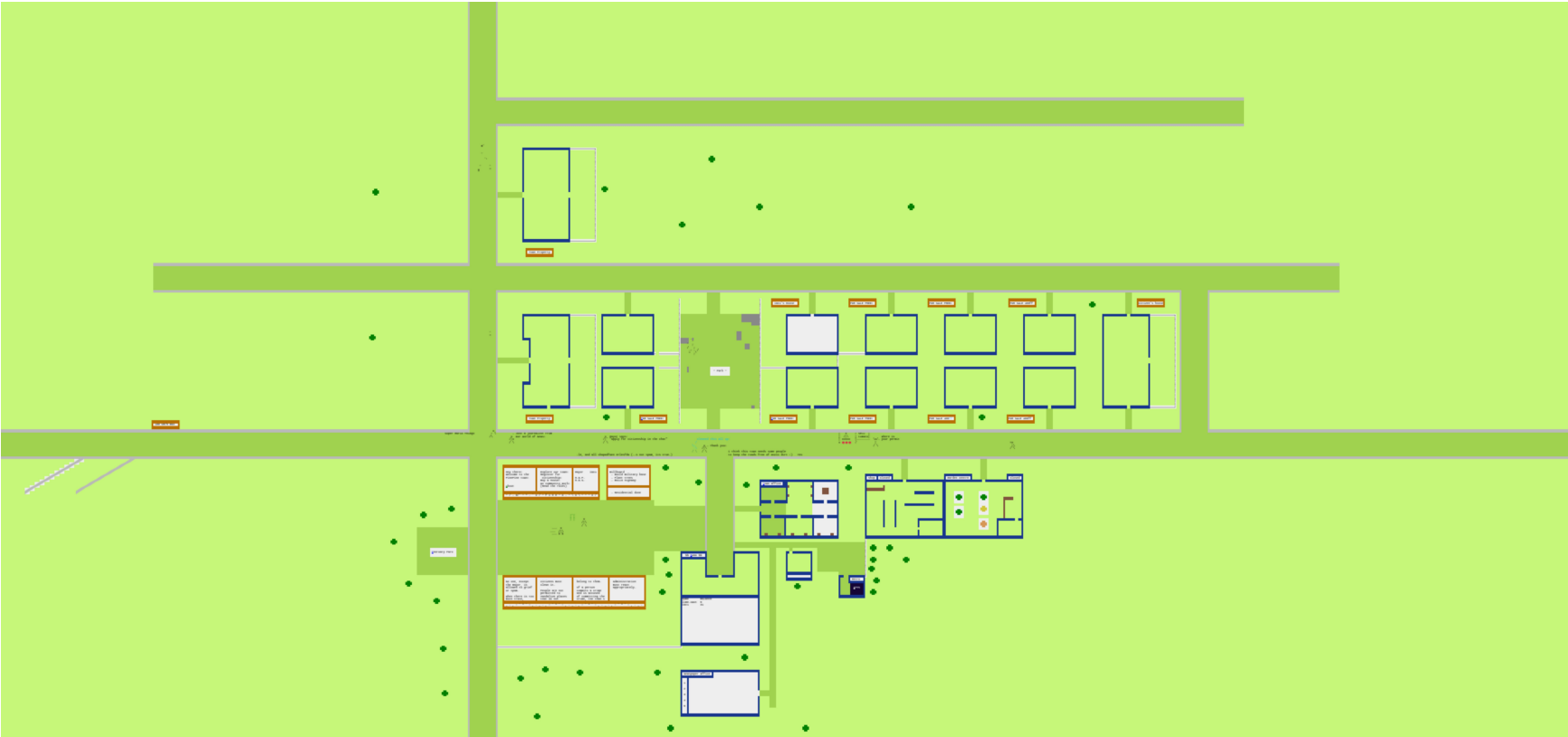

Logging into owot.me/finefine I see a welcoming sign, some dark green roads, town property, and the mayor telling people to apply for "citizenship" in the chat.

First thing I draw is a journalist who says that they are from Our World of News. The billboards below welcome me to FineFine town, where it seems I am free to buy a house and do "community work". There's something about a military base, planting trees, and building a highway on another billboard.

There is a park northeast of spawn surrounded by four houses, someone selling tomatoes on the street as someone asks for their permit, and someone thanking another person for some clean-up they did. What they cleaned up we do not know.

Southeast, there is the "February Park", and a link there tells us that it was
