Red Dog Valley Retrievers breeder Kenneth and Melissa Woytaszek, located at 14489 Leer Rd, Posen, MI 49776, is entering an agreement with buyer:

1) Deposit, Pick-Up Terms & Refund Exceptions

The buyer acknowledges that the \$500 deposit is non-refundable. Upon receipt of the deposit, the breeder agrees to hold the puppy designated by the buyer until full payment is received and the puppy is weaned and ready to go home.

- Puppies may leave no earlier than 8 weeks of age.
- Puppy must be picked up by 9 weeks of age, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- Pick-up date: ____ / ____ / ____

If the puppy is not picked up by 9 weeks and no written agreement is made, a boarding fee of \$20 per day may be applied, or the puppy may be placed back up for sale at breeder's discretion.

Deposit Refund Exceptions

The deposit will only be refunded under the following circumstances:

1. Ember does not pass her required eye exam or other mandatory physical health examinations, resulting in cancellation of the planned breeding.
2. Ember does not produce enough puppies to satisfy all deposits received. Deposits will be honored in the order they were received.
3. There is no available puppy in the sex the buyer reserved (male or female), based on the buyer's original deposit selection.

If any of these conditions occur, the buyer may choose to receive a full refund or transfer the deposit to a future litter.

2) Payment Requirements

Buyer acknowledges that full payment must be made prior to transfer of ownership. The total price of \$__2,500__ does not include shipping or delivery fees. Any transportation costs are the responsibility of the buyer.

3) Rehoming Requirement

Buyer agrees that if the dog ever needs to be rehomed, the breeder must be contacted first.

Under no circumstances may the dog be surrendered to a shelter, rescue, or sold/given away without breeder notification. Breeder retains first right of refusal to take the dog back or assist in placement.

4) Two-Year Health Warranty

We offer a two-year hereditary health warranty covering only genetic conditions for which the sire and dam were tested.

If OFA orthopedic hip or elbow evaluations do not pass at 24 months, the breeder must be contacted. Buyer must provide:

- Radiographic images
- Written veterinary diagnosis
- Proof of OFA submission
- Documentation must be provided before the dog reaches 26 months

Cardiac disease must be diagnosed by a licensed veterinary cardiologist.

Eye disease must be diagnosed by a licensed veterinary ophthalmologist.

If all documentation is provided and the dog is returned to the breeder, a refund minus deposit will be issued.

If the buyer chooses to keep the dog, refund amount is at breeder's discretion.

Proof of spay/neuter is required if the dog is kept.

5) Warranty Exclusions

The health warranty does not cover:

- Trauma or injury
- Flea/tick-borne disease
- Heartworm disease
- Illness caused by neglect, poor nutrition, or lack of veterinary care

Buyer is strongly encouraged to maintain year-round parasite prevention through their veterinarian.

6) Warranty Conditions

Warranty is valid only if:

- The dog is 26 months old or younger
- The dog has never sired or whelped a litter
- The dog's AKC registered name includes "Red Dog Valley Retrievers"
- The owner is the original buyer who signed this contract

Failure to meet these conditions voids the warranty.

7) Registration

Puppy will be sold with limited AKC registration.

Limited registration means the dog may be registered, but offspring cannot be registered.

Full registration may be granted only after the dog passes all required health clearances:

- OFA hips
- OFA elbows
- OFA eyes
- OFA cardiac
- Golden Retriever DNA panel (PRA1, PRA2, PRCD, DM, ICH, NCL)

All results must be submitted to OFA and provided to the breeder.

8) Veterinary Care Prior to Pickup

All puppies will receive their first veterinary examination, age-appropriate vaccinations, and routine deworming prior to leaving for their new homes.

A copy of the veterinary record, including vaccine dates, deworming schedule, and overall health assessment, will be provided to the buyer at pickup.

The breeder certifies that the puppy will be in good health to the best of their knowledge at the time of transfer.

9) Care & Welfare Clause

Buyer agrees to provide:

- Proper nutrition
- Routine veterinary care
- Safe housing
- Adequate exercise and socialization

If evidence of neglect or abuse is discovered, the breeder reserves the right to reclaim the dog with no refund.

10) No Breeder Liability for Buyer Expenses

Breeder is not responsible for any veterinary bills, training costs, damages, or expenses incurred by the buyer after the puppy leaves breeder's care.

11) Return Policy

If the buyer chooses to return the puppy for any non-health-related reason:

- No refund is guaranteed
- Refund amount, if any, is at breeder's discretion
- Puppy must be returned with registration papers
