Introduction:

Totally Spies! ran for six seasons between 2001 and 2013 and followed the story of Sam, Clover and Alex – three Beverly Hills girls who were hired as secret agents by Jerry, the owner of a clandestine spy organization called WOOHP (The World Organization of Human Protection). As it's been 9 years since the sixth season launched and there is still a large and passionate fanbase, we think now is the perfect time to bring back a refreshed *Totally Spies!* series for a new audience as well as the existing fans.

New Season/WOOHP World:

The girls are now living in **Singapore** – the most high-tech city in the entire world. But bye-bye fabulous Beverly Hills mansion – now we find the girls living the real student lifestyle in a studio-style apartment sitting above **I Spy Bubble Café** – their fave bubble tea-shop! They also attend **AIYA Academy** (Asian-International Youth Academy), a cutting-edge school that can only be described as awesome! (No, really... AIYA actually *means* awesome.) And not only are they getting to experience a whole new culture, but they also get to attend classes with diverse students from all over the planet (including their cool new Singaporean friend **Glitterstar!**)

But this exciting new life is actually a cover for why the girls are really in Singapore: to attend the elite WOOHP training programme at **WOOHP World**, a big, bustling world-unto-itself located right in the heart of Singapore! (Though, thanks to the invisible energy field that surrounds WOOHP World, no one in the surrounding city can see it!).

Their 'invitation' to WOOHP World came from **Zerlina** – or "Zer" for short, the girls' new boss and head of WOOHP World. Turns out, Jerry's decided to retire (end of Episode 701) and is now a consultant for WOOHP, but he's keeping a friendly eye on his team from Beverly Hills, so don't for a minute think he's out of the picture. As for Zerlina, she more than fills the bill. She's a smart, savvy, and utterly inspirational woman whom the girls look up to. Oh – and she's also Jerry's daughter. So expect the best and don't bring your excuses. Luckily the girls are stoked! Sam: "Go Zerlina!" Clover: "Welcome to the team!" Alex: "Yeah, the baddies won't stand a chance now!"

But Zerlina's not the only new face around the office. There's also **Toby** – the laid-back gadget-guru/Command Center operator with a limb difference who makes sure Sam, Clover and Alex have all the latest and greatest gear they need to kick butt! He's upgraded their spy suits and compowers, and added some drones and pixel gloves into the mix.

And speaking of kicking butt... that's EXACTLY what Sam, Clover and Alex do as they embark on new missions, face off against new baddies, and protect the planet from whatever spy-tastic obstacles come their way, including **Mandy**, their long-time Beverly Hills nemesis who



is now living in Singapore too. Infuriated by all the ‘fun’ the girls were having in Singapore (thanks, Clover, for vlogging about their new adventures at the AIYA Academy), Mandy has decided Cali-U and Beverly Hills are sooo yesterday and transfers to the AIYA Academy! And if that seems like a happy coincidence... think again...Mandy has WAY more up her sleeve...!

Not long after her arrival, there is a major uptick in criminal activity in Singapore – including the rise of a new uber-villain named **Cyberchac!** And soon our super sleuths find themselves pitted against giant cyber creepy crawlies, terrible toddlers and their giant sinkhole-inducing toys, as Cyberchac attempts to break into WOOHP World. Does he want to take it over? Or destroy it? And why? And will the spies ever be able to discover who is behind the Cyberchac mask and put an end to the chaos and mayhem they have unleashed on the island?!

Characters:

Though Sam, Clover and Alex remain the stars of the show, they’ve been updated to make them more relatable to girls today. They are fun and fresh – caring about all the things that modern girls care about like friendship, the environment, school, family, sports, and the online world. But don’t worry – they haven’t TOTALLY changed. They’re still fierce, independent and bursting with girl-power!!!

In this new season, we want to get deeper under each character’s skin and differentiate the girls more. We will find out what makes each of them tick, rather than just in a group. In seasons 1-6 the characters all liked a lot of the same things, but now, while they might all still like fashion, we want to know why they each like fashion based on their characters – i.e. Clover has a fashion vlog / Sam likes the science of clothes / Alex likes sustainable fashion solutions.

As for the language, this will be updated without losing who they are. Lots of this will come from their characterization but we’ll dial back slightly on the ‘Valley girl’ speak. Except, of course, for ‘totally’. We are TOTALLY keeping that!

Sam

Sam has always been the spy who leads with her brain, but now she’s gone full-on STEAM girl. She’s not afraid to geek-out over science, technology, engineering or math (making Singapore an AWESOME place for her) but now she’s exploring the A for Artistic side of her personality. With the help of their new artistic pal, Glitterstar (more on her later), Sam starts expressing her creative side and we’ll see her getting into design, especially in the gaming space. Because of her smarts, she can usually outwit bad guys with her problem-solving skills and quick thinking. Be it diffusing a rocket or figuring out how to infiltrate a villain’s labyrinthine lair by re-writing the security code, Sam is the girl-with-the-plan and the person Clover and Alex rely on to figure out the tech stuff while on missions.

Of course, they also rely on Sam in *regular* life too... like when they need help with homework or updating their smart phones. And Sam always supports them with a smile. Sam also has a huge passion for uber-competitive gaming. Alex and Clover frequently walk in on her in a VR



helmet lashing out at unseen digital foes while playing with and against other online gamers – shouting at the top of her lungs: “Yesss!!! I conquered the ice dragon! I win!!!” Way to level-up, Sammy. But Sam doesn’t stop there: she’s about to create her own game and can’t wait to launch it to the gaming community. And back off Mandy, no-one needs your negative reviews! Leaning more into Sam’s gamer lifestyle is where we’ll get to see Sam’s more maverick side, one that takes chances – she lets loose and is more than just being the ‘big sister’.

Clover

Clover has always been the most stylish, chic and sassy of our trio, but now we’re going to see funnier, more loveable, and more empathetic moments from Clover so we love her more.

She is an extraordinary extrovert who charms everyone around her and is the spy that’s always on the fashion pulse. So if the girls need to go undercover at a movie premiere or infiltrate a bustling Hawker Centre to ferret out a villain, they can feel confident that Clover knows the intricacies of looking the part. However, even though fashion is her passion, Clover will learn that FAST fashion is a problem from Alex and will start exploring thrifting, recycling clothes and upcycling.

Clover keeps her friends and family back home in California updated via her vlog of their new life in Singapore: 'Singapore Style caught by Clover' - keeping you up to speed with the latest fashion and action! Whether it’s sharing a fun fashion find, demonstrating with Glitterstar how to make bubble tea, or recording an awesome Singapore-style skincare tutorial for her friends, Clover will be on it! But as put together as Clover usually is, her complete and utter irrational fear of bugs can make her lose her composure and leap into her friends’ arms in a flash! And by bugs we mean the creepy-crawly kind, the mechanical kind... or even the espionage/eavesdropping kind for that matter. “Just please don’t say the ‘B’ word!”

As for boys... well believe it or not, she has a platonic friendship with TOBY (their new Woohp Gadget Guru). Yep, she doesn’t see him as a crush at all: they are just great friends. This is a big departure from her usual crushing on every boy, which surprises everyone. Including Clover! But don’t think it’s all plain sailing for Clover... her old heartthrob Blaine will make some surprise returns in S7 and those heartstrings will get pulled in every direction – usually ending in a total comedy tangle!

Alex

Alex was always sporty... but now she’s gone full elite athlete – really testing her limits. Whether it’s training for a double pentathlon, entering a giant wave surfing competition, or leaping from the WOHP chopper into a baddie’s blimp, Alex has taken her sporting career to a new level. The only problem is now she’s competing at a higher level, Alex’s competition just got a lot more fierce. Now Alex has to try twice as hard to compete and win.

She’s also never met a cause she didn’t want to get behind and is a total environmentalist and social-justice warrior. Which is why she’s a member of Habitat for Hedgehogs, attends every Save The Rainclouds rally around and recently joined Save the Salamanders. So in S7 we will



see Alex embracing roles as an eco-activist, championing green technology and pursuing sustainable alternatives.

To make her more capable on missions, Alex follows her instincts, taking risks because it wouldn't occur to her to be afraid. That terrifying dark hole in the wall? She's already got her hand in, rooting around for a lever to pull. Working with WOOHP teaches her to trust her instincts and she applies this to everything in her life. She's the most empathetic of our characters – which is a real strength when it comes to dealing with the cheeky, unpredictable nature of the drones.

And though Alex can be charmingly naïve (as in voted Most-Likely-To-Trust-A-Bad-Guy three years in a row) and still can't drive/fly/steer any kind of vehicle to save her life, it really doesn't matter. Because she's the kindest, nicest friend anyone – especially Sam and Clover – could ever ask for!

Zerlina

Zerlina is smart, worldly, witty and the very definition of fabulous! And she's also Jerry's dual-heritage daughter. But although she's the perfect choice for the job, Jerry isn't that happy that Zerlina is WOOHP's new boss because he's worried about her, NOT because he's jealous as the girls erroneously think. Zerlina is the consummate professional and would never be caught on camera appearing 'off duty'. But she does let her badass side show when she's flying through Singapore on her souped-up, only Zerlina knows how to ride, motorbike. Could she get any cooler?

Zerlina's main weakness is that she's overprotective towards her dad, Jerry. If she thinks he's in trouble, all her strategy goes out the window and she'll throw all the WW resources at the problem, whether it's needed or not. And she does have a major obsession with Bubble Tea! She just can't get enough and has even created a secret portal from I Spy Bubble Tea down into WW, so she can get a tea whenever she wants one.

Zer developed a passion for board games, chess, backgammon etc, during really boring weekends at her English boarding school. And her office always has a game in play - not just for the fun of it. Instead, she uses them to hone her strategic thinking and leans into the NON tech aspect of strategy. This is one of her huge strengths and so when the tech fails, Zerlina reminds the trio of the analogue way. Not because she's old, but rather because she's too smart to be tech-dependent. And because, well she was brought up by the best – Jerry.

Each of the girls look up to Zerlina as a role model, and why wouldn't they? She's everything the spies aspire to be and then some! And though she's very nice and even a bit of a mom-figure to Sam, Clover and Alex, when it's mission time she is ALL about business and takes charge like no other! With Toby, her relationship is more like big sister – and the two of them are often seen gently teasing each other.

Toby



Toby is the disabled gadget-guru who creates all the new spy gizmos for WOOHP's agents in his Fab Lab. Toby not only dispenses gadgets to Sam, Clover and Alex before/during their missions, but he can also give them logistics support when they need it on the mission. Toby is in no way an inside-the-box thinker, he is constantly problem solving to meet his access needs and definitely does not live by-the-book. This is why the girls liked him the moment they met him. That, and the fact that he's the same age as them, has an awesomely laid/back low-key demeanor and plays up Zerlina in a funny younger brother type of way.

Toby is really interested in ergonomics and is a gifted tailor who found a passion of engineering amazing wearable gadgets after growing up with a limb difference. After many prototypes, he has created his own bionic arm tech and is always up for integrating a new cool gadget to it (like drone blades! You never know when you need an arm to fly in and save the day!). But outside of WOOHP World, Toby will sometimes choose not to wear his mobility aid – it's tiring wearing something heavy all day. Toby is very comfortable talking about his disability – and doesn't shy away from answering questions if asked.

Despite working for a spy agency, Toby is very clear he doesn't make weapons, he makes gadgets to help people. He's got great fashion sense himself, but also uses it for spy research purposes. He likes to express himself through his clothing. He was born and raised in Singapore and his parents are from India, he's interested in his heritage, something which he shares with Alex and her Latina background. Though Toby has the ability to *spea*k geek (which Sam totally gets), don't be fooled. He's one of the coolest and most hard-working agents WOOHP has ever seen.

Jerry

After creating/running/working as a spy at WOOHP for many years, Jerry was pleased to finally retire and hand the baton over – it's just that he would have preferred not to hand it to his daughter. It's not that he doesn't think Zerlina is more than capable – it's just that as a father he can't help but worry about his daughter running the world's most secret spy agency. But just because Jerry has stepped down as WOOHP's spy-boss doesn't mean he's completely out of the game. He now works as a consultant at WOOHP World – doing everything from quality control (like making sure the muffins in the WOOHP cafeteria have just the right ratio of walnut to banana) to serving as a part-time instructor for new recruits ('cause he can still slay the rock-climbing wall with the best of 'em) and keeping the agents fit with some aqua-aerobics along the way. He also loves to visit the agency to check in on his favorite spies: Sam, Clover and Alex – and he'll find any excuse just to pop his head round the door to check on Zerlina. Time for tea anyone?!

Glitterstar

Glitterstar (Malaysian Chinese) is a super cool, artistic girl who goes to school with Sam, Clover and Alex. She's a talented artist exploring new mediums and formats and also works at the local café, I Spy Bubble Café. Glitterstar is very different to the trio – she seems to operate on her own frequency, creating her own trends and is never worried about popularity or other people's opinions.



She's very cool, follows her own rules – fashion and otherwise – and is unpredictable and exciting – one minute she's contemplating her next Bubble Tea recipe and the next she's got the girls rolling across the Singapore gardens in Zorb balls! As soon as the Spies meet her, they are all super keen to impress Glitterstar. They become great friends as the season progresses and Glitterstar is also a killer tour guide – knowing all the ins and outs of Singapore since she was born and raised there. And no matter how many times the spies almost blow their spy cover around her, comedically, Glitterstar never picks up on the fact that her new friends are secret agents. She will provide the series with a contrasting 'voice' to the girls – but no less fun or endearing!

Cyberchac

Masked uber-villain Cyberchac is a tech-genius, unleashing all manner of new technology on Singapore in his effort to discover where WOOHP World is and break into it. The girls manage to contain whatever tech-nightmare he has dispatched on the city but are frustrated they can't fathom out who is behind his emoji-faced mask – and, indeed, what exactly the villain is after! Does he want to destroy WOOHP World when he finally finds it or take over and run his own uber villain organization accessing its mainframe underneath? Just who – or what – exactly is he... or indeed is Cyberchac a SHE?!?!? As the series unfolds, it will become clear that Cyberchac is indeed a SHE as this uber-villain is in fact MANDY (the spies' former nemesis and college classmate at Mali-U) inside the most awesome digi-tech-suit ever! That is until the A.I. suit takes on a life of its own...

Mandy

As fate would have it, Sam, Clover and Alex shockingly realize that their old nemesis Mandy is also attending AIYA Academy as an exchange student. Why? Because she was like SO super not happy that the girls were having such a great time in Singapore – thanks for the vlog-updates Clover! *Yeeeah!* Besides Mali-U and Beverly Hills are so like, YESTERDAY! At least that's the story she's spinning to the girls as she sits sky-high in her cool city-centre penthouse. The girls will be TOTALLY shocked when they find out REALLY what Mandy's plan – and just how connected to Cyberchac she is!

But even though the girls would never admit it, they sometimes find Mandy's annoying shenanigans a comforting reminder of home... until they aren't!

The World They Live In:

From its awe-inspiring skyscrapers with suspended walkways and rooftop infinity pools; to its incredible shopping boutiques filled with luxury goods unlike any the girls have ever seen before; to the white sand beaches that connect to aqua-blue water, Singapore is beyond impressive! But the MOST impressive part is that the entire city has an infrastructure wired with absolutely mind-blowing technology at every turn. Like drone delivery services. And interactive talking billboards. Service bots and taxi cabs that literally drive themselves. Sam: "Whoa." Clover: "OMG!!" Alex: "No way!!!"

And in the center of it all is AIYA Academy – a school so now and so wow that it literally caused Sam, Clover and Alex's jaws to drop to the floor. Because not only is it filled with all the bells



and whistles a student could ever desire, but because it's filled with diverse teens from all over the globe. The AIYA Academy is in the EAST gardens of Singapore Bay, near the golf course overlooking the bay. Whereas the girls' studio apartment (waaay different from their Beverly Hills mansions and Mali-U dormitories) is above the I Spy Bubble Café, in the cool BUGIS district, with the typical architectural style of old Singapore, young, cool and trendy with pop culture painted walls.

And speaking of WOOHP World... welcome to spy central where nothing is at it seems. WW is a timeless place with a fat dose of the fantastical and is a very different environment from the futuristic Singapore sitting above and around it. In WW, looks are always deceiving so watch out - that normal-looking drink could actually be a prototype for a zero-gravity solution. WOOHP World in Singapore is the HQ to ALL the WOOHPs centers around the world, like a central hub. It sits on the WOOHP mainframe that powers all international hubs – and their WOOHP-r's. If a new WOOHP international hub opens (like in Venice!) then WOOHP World will send them a WOOHP-r for their agents via the WOOHP Express – an awesome train that powers round the world on invisible tracks (and before you ask, no you can't WOOHP a WOOHP-r – *that* would be 'explosive'!). WOOHP World is the number one spy training ground recruiting an elite core of WOOHP agents from around the globe. It offers high tech spy training experiences and digital simulations in the All-Terrain Simulation Dome. Retinal-scan stations and virtual doorways that could lead anywhere, and multiple climates that adjust to whatever you're doing: wanna learn how to ski for that mission in the Alps? The dome can offer all and more. Maybe some sub-aqua training is needed for that mission to a rumoured Atlantis rebuild off the coast of Madagascar – then enter the SinkTank. Feeling retro? There's even a storage room containing old world gadgets because you never know what might come in handy... like landline telephones, record players and pocket watches! And then there's the coolest vehicle 'garage' in town – a giant cavernous space where the spies can test ride all the latest vehicles, from tunnel-diggers to anti-gravity motorbikes and rockets! (Toby's created some padding around the edges for when Alex gives things a go!). Exhausted by all that training? Refuel at the fully-automated WOOHP cafeteria! If you're lucky Jerry might be serving up one of his specialty buns.

Of course, any leading spy center MUST have a cutting-edge lab and WW is no exception. Welcome to Toby's Fab Lab, where he cranks out all sorts of cool gadgets and gear. Some examples include: upgraded Holographic Compowers fully-loaded with all sorts of awesome WOOHP apps (that Sam absolutely loves); a new, environmentally-friendly Backpack with flo-gravity wings that accommodate a spy drone (Alex's fave); Pixel-gloves to use when they need to control/fix a digital problem; enhanced Suction-Bottom Boots and Bungee Belts; and BLOWMAKs... Blow-Me-A-Kiss Wall-Disintegrating Lipsticks in all the hot colors for Fall (you're welcome, Clover)! And, of course, the girls' uniforms have also been updated with the latest tech *and* the latest style which is all controlled from a forearm touch screen. S7 will see our spies out and about on missions each accompanied by their own individual drone – and when we say 'individual' we mean that. These little digital critters are not without personality – and can be a little bit infuriating when they decide to do things their way.



But the cherry on top of the gadget-and-gear sundae is the **WOOHP-E!** – an eye-popping, fully-electric, convertible sports car that Zerlina and Toby can give Sam, Clover and Alex when it's not in use by other spy cadets. Not only can it change color (to help you blend into your surroundings or simply to match your mood), but if there's a traffic jam the car simply hovers up and above the other vehicles. Alex: "Awesome! I can't wait to drive!" Sam: "Think again, Alex." Clover: "Yeah. We're actually trying to *survive* our time in Singapore." But don't get too attached – sometimes the WOOHP-E is just not available and the girls will find themselves travelling by bus, or cramming all together on an e-scooter!

Season Theme:

The theme of the new season will be all about understanding that things – and people - are not always what they seem. Just like WOOHP World. Moreover, living in a new and unfamiliar city, the spies will quickly discover that those old 'rules' they used to figure people out and understand their environment don't work outside of Mali-U. Time to throw them out the window – and not judge a book by its cover! Clover is quick to embrace all the new fashion styles, vlogging about it all as she learns what's 'in' and what's definitely 'out' in Singapore. Additionally, just because something looks cool, is it really? Because Alex is quick to show that if it's been made from unsustainable stuff then there's nothing cool about THAT. And Sam is blown away by the technology around her – a simple street cleaning bot? That can also deliver your food AND send intel back to the police on minor street issues – do NOT drop that litter!

Season Arcs:

This season's arc is shaped by the Mandy/Cyberchac story and Mandy/Cyberchac's attempts to break into WOOHP World and prove herself to Zerlina that she deserves a spot on the spy team. The season concludes with a 2-parter where Cyberchac's identity is finally unveiled: it's Mandy behind the mask! But Cyberchac is not ready to be a discarded digital suit on the WOOHP World recycling pile and returns as an advanced AI without Mandy pulling the strings. Cyberchac is set on revenge and determined to takeover WOOHP World and run things his way...

All episodes will work as stand-alones, but TS fans will enjoy seeing the arc play out.

The Backstory – Mandy creates Cyberchac

When Mandy helps herself to the girls' special coconut sunscreen on the beach in Malibu (after the spies have been WOOHPED from their beach picnic) – she can't help but notice it has a very distinctive smell. She takes a long sniff – hmmm – nice and then PING! Her eyes go cross-eyed – that smell – she knows it! It's Jerry's undercover spy sunscreen special! OMG! The smell triggers all her spy-memories*¹ which come flooding back in. Summer Tech Camp has been SO dull, she wants back in as a spy! Unfortunately, it's a flat no from Jerry.

But seeing how totally awesome the spies' new lives in Singapore are looking (via Clover's vlogs), she concocts a plan to prove she deserves to be back in the WOOHP team: she'll find

her way in to WOOHP World using any means possible, demonstrating her ‘super-spy skills’. To assist her in her new scheme, she builds the CYBERCHAC suit (think Iron Man’s Jarvis), putting her hours of tech-summer camp to good use. But the suit’s A.I. might be paying more attention to her than she realises...

Cyberchac 2.0

Once Mandy achieves her goal and gets into WOOHP World, the agents toss the Cyberchac suit into the WOOHP Recycling, much to Mandy’s irritation. But then, out of sight, its inner A.I. (Cyberchac 2.0) turns on, determined to finish what it *thinks* is the job: to take over WOOHP World and run it alongside his creator, Mandy! And if that means getting rid of ALL the agents and our much-beloved spies, then so be it!

Mandy/Cyberchac Tentpole Episodes at a Glance:

The Mandy/Cyberchac stories will take place over tentpole episodes, each with a standalone story:

Episode Number / Title	Details
Ep 701 –Frankenpanda	The origin story – how the spies and Mandy end up in Singapore
Ep 705 – Creepy Crawly Creature Catcher	Mandy/Cyberchac uses giant creepy-crawlies to cause havoc in an attempt to locate an entrance into WW
Ep 709 – Terrible Toddler Toys	Mandy/Cyberchac uses giant babies and their toys to try and tunnel into WW
Ep 720 - Totally Pawsome	Mandy/Cyberchac teams up with another villain to use adorable kittens to infiltrate WW
Ep 725 – Locked in Space	Mandy unveils herself and the Cyberchac suit is discarded
Ep 726 – Cyber Sweetheart	Cyberchac 2.0 is back and seeking revenge.

NOTE: Mandy will feature in several early episodes in the B-STORY/SCHOOL PLOT. Our TS fanbase will enjoy watching these episodes and spotting the ‘Easter Egg’ moments: the hints and clues as to what Mandy was really up to. But for our ‘drop-in’ audience, the episodes will work as stand-alones. And, after Mandy/Cyberchac’s attempts to break into WOOHP World have been thwarted a couple of times, Mandy/Cyberchac will team up with another villain (Cleocatra) in the hope they’ll help her get into WW.

A Summary of the Mandy/Cyberchac Series Arc:

- **EP 1 FRANKENPANDA (NON-CYBERCHAC EPISODE)**

The spies’ long summer break of awesome Malibu fun is rudely interrupted when they are WOOHPed right off their sunloungers to a mission in Singapore (cue moment of Mandy helping herself to their sunscreen and the smell triggering a return of all her spy memories). At the end of their mission, Jerry has some news that is going to change their lives! Having completed their 1000th mission they’ve been signed up to the elite spy squad based at WOOHP WORLD! Say whaaat?!?! WOOHP WORLD?!?!? What and where is that then?! The spies are lost for words when Jerry introduces



them to the WOOHP 'mothership', a city within a city for elite, top spies, hidden by a digital membrane right there in the centre of Singapore! A-MAZE-ING! Not only that but there's a new boss in town – ZERLINA – the spies will be taking orders from her from now on. Jerry's stepping down – but not out. He'll see them around WOOHP World in an 'advisory capacity'. In the meantime, he's going to enjoy flexing his culinary skills. And the spies will be flexing their spy skills as they undergo some advanced training in WOOHP World in-between their usual missions of course! But the spies protest – they've got their last year of studies to finish at Mali-U! No problem – they're already enrolled in the AIYA Academy and will be living in new student apartment above the I Spy Bubble Café.

- **Ep 2 – It Takes a Slob (NON-CYBERCHAC EPISODE)**
