

Week 1&2 SAT Enchridion Workshop

The SAT Enchridion book is 19 chapters long, a chapter corresponds to each section of the SAT Question-Bank. We're gonna go through explaining every section of the SAT Question-Bank and how to solve each part with Desmos in the most efficient way possible, and all types of questions from that section that turn up on the test

We'd go through it in 4 sessions, One session for Algebra, another for Advanced Math, another for Statistics, and another for Geometry and Trigonometry.

There will be two days in-between each session in which you have time to solve the homework, the homework will be all of the medium and hard questions for that section on the SAT QB, which is about an average of 130 questions on each day.

You're expected to document your mistakes from the homework and send them before the session, because we have a one-on-one session for each student where we go through their mistakes and explain each one before moving on to the next lesson.



Weeks 2-6 Practice Camp

After going through every single topic and learning from all the types of mistakes we could make, we'd move on to the highest ROI work which is (Past Exams, and Hardest Questions)

These are the questions that will for sure turn up on your test, the SAT repeats the majority of its questions and if they are not repeated, then it is very likely it will be the same topic as a question that has already been asked in the past.

Questions that have never been repeated before are experimental questions that aren't normally graded in your score.

We would do 4 math Exams per week in this camp. With one-on-one live revision based on mistakes after every exam, going through both the questions you got wrong and the questions that took you a long time to solve.

In parallel, we would go through a list of the 780 HARDEST SAT Questions that have ever been on the exam, with 50% of our work being randomized and 50% being based on your mistakes from the past test. with 40 of a list of 780 hardest questions assigned after the exams.



Week 1&2 **SAT Enchridion Workshop** (5-6hrs live session, 13-17hrs hw per week)

a group session (1-1:30hrs) twice a week (4 sessions in total)

one-on-one session discussing mistakes in homework on the same day (1hr)

medium-difficulty question homework after the session

hard-difficulty question homework the day after

(total, about 260 per lecture, 520 spread over 4 days)

Weeks 2-6 **Practice Camp** (4-5.5 hrs live sessions, 4 hrs practice tests, 4-5.5 hrs homework per week (8-9.5 hrs), ~12-15 hrs per week)

Solving four past-exams each week

one-on-one session discussing mistakes in the past exam the day after (1-1:30hrs)

~40 question homework from the hardest compilation of SAT Questions

Personalized and Randomized selection differs according to number of mistakes

30-40hrs of teaching per cohort
