FINANCIAL HEALTH TIPS FOR LOCAL CLUBS

#11 Get a Fresh Set of Eyes on Your Books

From the Desk of the National Finance Chair

When you're focused on your mission, finances can feel like an afterthought. These tips will help you stay on track without adding extra work.

Outside Perspective Matters

You don't need a CFO, but having someone outside your core team review your books can prevent costly mistakes. Internal reviews are helpful, but best practice is to have a professional review your financial records at least annually. This doesn't always mean a full audit—many small nonprofits opt for a financial review or compilation, which is less expensive but still provides an independent check.

Why It Matters:

- Detects errors or irregularities early
- Strengthens donor confidence and credibility
- Helps ensure compliance with nonprofit regulations

Options for Professional Oversight:

- Annual Review by a CPA: A formal review or compilation is often sufficient for small nonprofits.
- Volunteer Accountant: If funds are tight, ask if a member or supporter with accounting experience can help.
- Peer Review: Partner with another local nonprofit to exchange financial reviews.

Quick Start Checklist:

- ✓ Ask members if they know someone with a financial background
- ✓ Schedule an annual or semi-annual review by a CPA or qualified volunteer
- ✓ Use the review to improve processes and strengthen internal controls

Pro Tip: If your organization receives grants or significant donations, a professional review may be required by funders—plan ahead to avoid surprises.

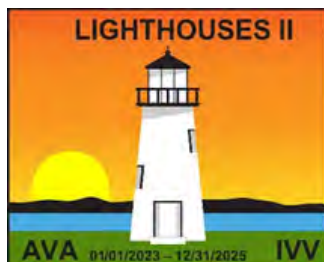

AWARDS AND RECOGNITION COMMITTEE – KEN JOHNSON, MEMBER

This is the second in a series of articles about the Awards Committee and its administration of the AVA Recognition Awards Program. Last month we featured the prestigious Hall of Fame Award. This month, AVA's second highest honor: The AVA Distinguished Achievement Award.

AVA DISTINGUISHED ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The AVA may bestow the AVA Distinguished Achievement Award upon individuals who have given at least eight years of service to the AVA. Personal contributions must have been made at an exemplary level at several stages of service, including national level. Nominated individuals should have previously received the Meritorious Service Award. An individual is eligible to receive this award more than once for different 8-year service periods. The award will be recognized by a framed certificate, pin, and patch.

The Distinguished Achievement Award follows the AVA Hall of Fame Award in the awards hierarchy. It may not be presented at each convention depending on the nomination status. However, more than one award may be presented at convention. The first four were given out at the 1985 convention. To date, 198 individuals have been honored. The first were given to four individuals at the 1985 convention.

ABOUT THE COMMITTEE

The AVA Awards Committee is responsible for the development, implementation, and management of awards for clubs, individuals and organizations through the Board of Directors and CEO (Henry Rosales). These awards honor individuals and organizations, both within and outside the AVA for service, deeds, and accomplishments that have advanced the ideals and aspirations of volkssporting in the United States. Awards for national service are typically presented at the Biennial Convention. Regional recognition awards are presented by the Regional Director at regional, state or club events. Paid employees of the AVA do not qualify for the AVA Recognition Awards Program unless they are being recognized for serving in a volunteer capacity. AVA Board Officers, Directors and Deputy Directors are not eligible for national recognition awards while serving in those positions.

If you wish to nominate someone for a Distinguished Achievement Award, the Recognition Awards Nomination Form 302 is available on the AVA.org website under Clubs Only->Club Resources->Club Forms. Submit the form to your Regional Director. If you have any questions, both your Regional Director and members of the Awards Committee can assist you.

Don't forget to update your stamp information if you are changing the name of the event or need to request an extra stamp.

RD's must review and approve all events by September 15, 2023 in order to get them into the 2027 Starting Point book. Any approvals after the 15th do not guarantee a section in the 2027 Starting Point book.

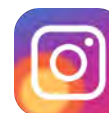
