



Applying for a bursary

We are pleased to be able to offer bursaries again this year to make the UK Sof-Vokh affordable to those who would otherwise find it difficult to attend. We are unlikely to have the same level of funding available as last year so may not be able to meet all requests in full. As a guide, we are likely to be offering bursaries of up to £150 this year but we will consider each application individually.

We will have two application rounds:

- The deadline for the first round is 30th April.
- The deadline for the second round is 31st May.

A small sub-group of the organising committee will consider applications for bursaries in confidence. We will aim to let applicants know whether or not they have been successful within 10 days of the deadline for each round.

For those applying in the first round, so long as you get your application in by 30th April, we will hold the early bird price until we give you an answer.
