



So You Wanna Mod Skyrim

A Guide By Lustful Luna

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## **This guide is specifically curated to provide you with**

- Mods that are the backbone dependencies for many other mods
- Suggestions to make your Skyrim look pretty, so that sexual animations and the characters involved actually look good
- Physics mods that give you breast bounce and genital collisions (what a time to be alive)
- The different types of core sex mods out there and how to set them up.
- Sex addons like quests, locations, and some utility mods etc etc.
- A few generally good mods to change and enhance gameplay, but that is not the primary focus of this guide/modlist. The objective is mainly to set up the sex and learn how to use them, then you're free to build your own custom Skyrim.

### **Before we get started! Please read this section!!!**

If you want to see an example of what this can look like before you go through the trouble of modding, you can watch this [video](#) ( I made this a while ago so everything before the 1 minute mark is no longer relevant but everything afterwards is) it shows unedited gameplay. Here are some other things to note:

- The video shows sex initiated on a whim, but there are mods to make the interaction more immersive that will be listed in this guide.
- The videos that you see on my twitter are also 100% made in Skyrim BUT they are heavily edited and I go through a lot of trouble to make them sound and look the way they do.

- I really recommend doing this on a new save, and to not commit to creating your character or doing quests until you've got your setup up and running.
- **If you're seeing this via Google Docs:** This is the most current mod guide that I plan to keep updated as time goes by. Ignore the bullet point below.
- **If you're seeing this via PDF:** This guide was made in January 2023 for Skyrim AE 1.6.640, it will probably stay relevant for a while but you can see the [google doc version](#) that I aim to keep up to date.

Manually modding Skyrim is really fun, but also frustrating at times. There is always the option of [wabbajack](#) where you can just find a nsfw modpack you like and let it do all the work for you! Licentia and masterstroke are two good examples off the top of my head.

**So why would anyone find a need for this guide?** Honestly that's the very reason as to why I held off on updating this guide for so long. But there are benefits to manually modding Skyrim such as choosing what you do and don't want on a mod by mod basis, and being able to choose what best fits your pc storage and graphics capabilities. Also, if NSFW mods are a huge priority for you, then I do think modding Skyrim manually is the way to go. Whether that is worth the cost of potential headaches is up for the individual to decide.

## Prerequisites

- **Generally know how to use a mod installer**

Modding Skyrim is pretty easy. If you don't know how to use one or which one to install I'll link a couple of examples. I use MO2 because I've been told it's the best.

- **Have a decently good computer**

Technically not a requirement since you can simply run potato vanilla Skyrim with sex mods if you really wanted to, but it will determine how much you can beautify your Skyrim without dropping too much frames. PC spec requirements will vary wildly based on how you want your game to look like. But just to give you a point of reference, I probably wouldn't bother on a computer that has something less powerful than a nvidia GTX 960, and with less of 55GB of spare Storage (The storage requirement is counting the base game + all mods needed + some extra mods to spice up the game). Of course, bigger is better when it comes down to this.

- **Be able to do your own research + troubleshooting if needed**

I did my best to simplify this as much as I can. And for the most part it will be easy, just be ready and ok with reading the forums of a mod if you're having trouble with it and youtube stuff too! **Please, do not contact me expecting me to be your personal IT support; everything I know regarding NSFW Skyrim is pretty much already typed out here!**

- **If you're doing a FRESH install be ready to commit quite a bit of time**

Mainly because you're starting from the beginning, and you will no doubt find other mods not listed here that you will want to install. But hey, that's part of the fun :^). If you are a newbie, it may take longer. You may get frustrated and run into issues, don't expect to get everything done in one day.

## “What Version Of Skyrim Should I Use?”

Nsfw Skyrim is possible on Skyrim LE, SE, and AE on PC. I've never used Skyrim VR but here's a [guide](#) for that version. Console players however, are completely out of luck. Out of all versions of Skyrim, I highly recommend AE. **Regardless of what version of Skyrim you choose, it has to have ALL DLC and be a legit non-pirated copy on STEAM (will not work for xbox gamepass) for PC.**

## “What's the difference?”

**LE-** Skyrim Legacy Edition, came out in 2013 and has all DLC, the main downside is that it is a 32-bit application. For you, this means that you are generally more likely to run into crashes. Also note The links I provide you will not work because they are meant for SE/AE, you will have to go either on the nexus or google to find them. The names for some of the mods may have very slightly changed between editions, and LE may require additional mods to work. So it is very important that you check the “requirements” tab on every mod that you download.

**AE-** Skyrim Anniversary edition (**1.6 and beyond**), came out in 2021, this is Skyrim SE with the most current update. Skyrim SE and AE are the same game, Skyrim SE was

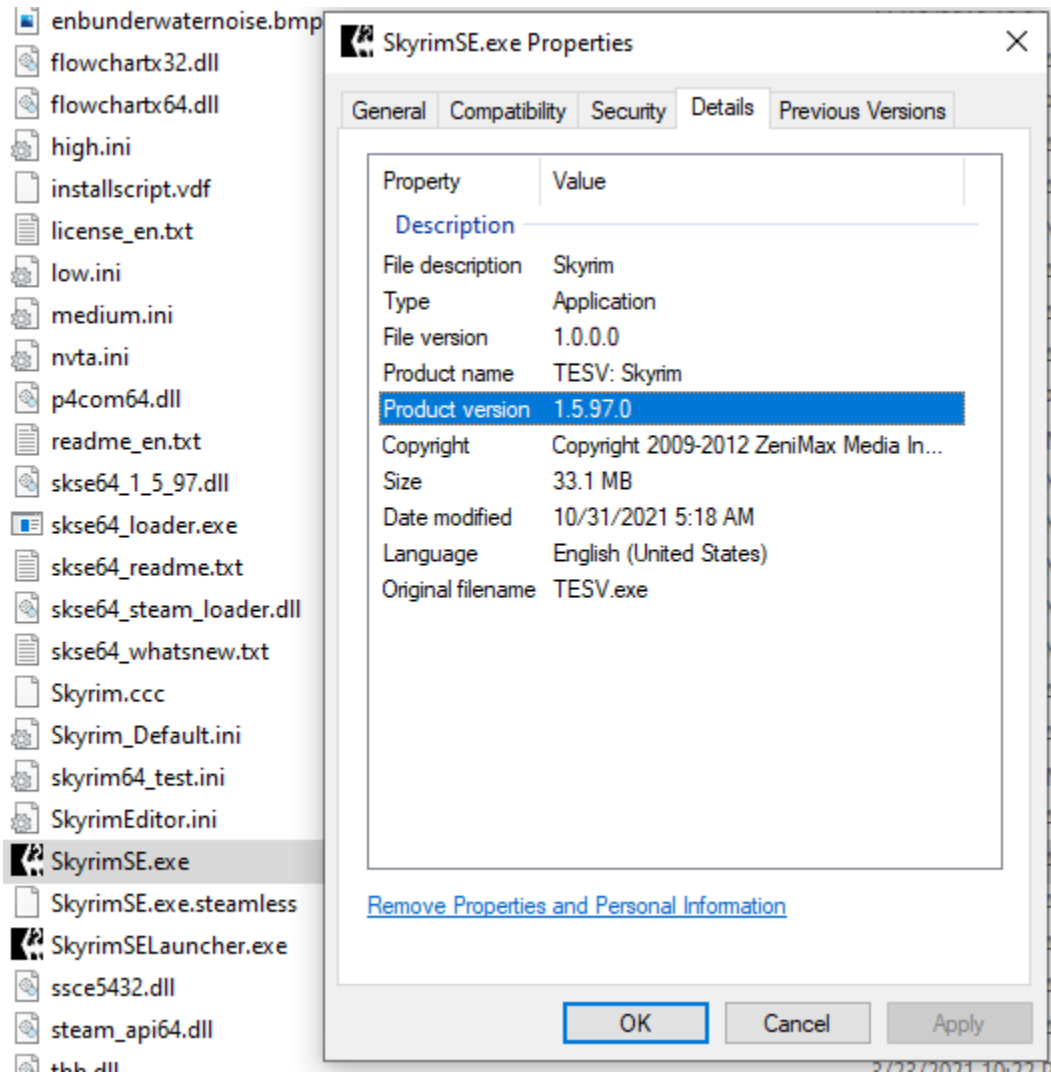
updated with several add ons and they rebranded it as Skyrim AE. The downside of this version of Skyrim is that Bethesda may one day decide to update Skyrim, meaning that any mod dependent on SKSE will in turn, also need to be updated. At the moment, 90% of the most used mods have been ported to AE. For the average person, AE will likely be the best option to go. After getting the setup you're satisfied with, I recommend you follow [this post](#) to ensure that Steam doesn't update Skyrim without your consent and break all your mods.

**SE**- Skyrim Special Edition ( **Ver 1.5.97 specifically**), came out in 2016. The way you access this is by getting and downloading Skyrim AE, then using this [Unofficial Skyrim Special Edition Downgrade Patcher](#) and it will turn your Skyrim AE into Skyrim SE 1.5.97.

The main reason anyone would want this would be to use mods that haven't been updated for SKSE for AE, which at this point, is a very very small and niche pool of mods. And that is why I generally recommend people to use AE.

## “What Version Do I have?”

if for whatever reason you're not sure what version of SE/AE you have, you can always right click the game executable > Properties > Details



So in this case it's 1.5.97. **It's important to know what game version you have, because it can determine which files you do or don't download!**

**Already have a modded Skyrim?** Cool! You can skip like 80% of this guide just browse the modlist so that you make sure you have all the necessary requirements.

That are marked by the: **(R)** Please note that I highly recommend you start a new save if you end up downloading a lot of mods from this list (It might work on your current save, I just can't make promises).

## **Part 1 The Foundations**

These mods will layout the base and foundations for the sex mods and regular mods you will install later. Any hard requirement will be marked with **(R)**, the other stuff will just be highly recommended. You can follow the general order of installation I provided and it should all work, later you can download a program called loot that will organize your load order for you if necessary. Be sure to double check that you have the requirements for every mod when downloading!

### **1. Skyrim Script extender (R)**

How to install and where to get it:

Skse extends scripting capabilities ingame, which many mods will require. Be sure to get the right version for your game. And from now on, you will launch Skyrim through SKSE executable, either from your mod manager or data folder. Do not launch via Steam.

**Attention: AE and SE users! Any mod that you download that has SKSE in the requirements means that it will *LIKELY* have an AE version and an SE version, make**



sure you get whichever one you are running. *Generally* speaking mods that do NOT have SKSE in the requirements (like texture packs) can be used both in AE and SE without issue. Remember! AE is Skyrim 1.6 and beyond, Skyrim SE is 1.5.97 and below if you're not sure what you have check Page 6 this guide!

Fixes bugs and stuff.

3. [Address Library for SKSE Plugins \(R\)](#)

This mod “contains header file and a database to make SKSE DLL plugins version independent easily” What does that mean? I have no clue, but it’s a hard requirement for some mods down this list so download it.

4. [SSE Engine Fixes \(R\)](#)

Fixes issues with the Skyrim engine, if you are using LE then download [crash fixes](#).

This mod has special instructions:

- [Go here](#) to download visual studio X64, run it and install.
- Download the first part of the mod and install.
- Download part 2 of the mod, extract and put the files in your Skyrim data folder.

5. [Alternate Start Live Another Life](#)

Recommended to make a new save, this mod will let you skip the opening helgen part so you can get right to the action.

**Check Point 1** - Run Skyrim just to make sure nothing explodes. Wait a minute or two, save, then quit. If something is wrong, then you can start backtracking to where you may have gone wrong. **I generally recommend you wait in creating your character until you finish installing mods.**

#### 6. [Sky UI](#) (R)

Changes the Skyrim inventory interface and adds a Mod Configuration Menu (MCM) in your pause menu under the system tab, where you can edit settings for many mods that you will download in this guide. The one file works for both AE and SE.

#### 7. [UIExtensions](#) (R)

Adds some additional menus that other mods will take advantage of. The one file works for both AE and SE.

#### 8. [QUI](#) (R)

Lets you explore plugins and any items that they have by pressing F11 in game, will come really handy later.

#### 9. [ConsoleUtili](#) (R)

Lets papyrus scripts execute console commands, needed for other mods.

#### 10. [Forces New Idles In Skyrim \(FNIS\)](#)

**If you do NOT want creature sex, you can skip this step.** If you do this is a hard requirement. This mod lets you add custom animations to characters and creatures. This mod has special instructions, download the XXL version and the creature FNIS as well, which is in the same link. The SE version works for both SE/AE. After installing go into your Skyrim data folder (or launch via mod manager) and click on the tools folder, look for the “generateFNISforusers” application and run it. Click “Update FNIS behavior” and let it do its thing and then close it.. **Then after that anytime you install/uninstall any animation mod you will have to run FNIS to update the animations in your game. If you forget this step your characters and NPCs will T-pose!**

#### 11. [Nemesis](#) (R)

This mod is basically a newer, more capable version of FNIS, but at the time of this writing (typing?) it does not support creature animations. But there are some animation mods that require Nemesis as opposed to FNIS. **So to put it simply for the user:**

**Plan on using custom animations for characters but not creatures? Download Nemesis only.**

**Plan on using custom animations for both characters and creatures? Download both Nemesis and FNIS.**

Anyway, after installing look for the “Nemesis Unlimited Behavior Engine” application that should be in the nemesis folder that is inside your data folder. Click on update “update engine” and “Launch behavior engine” .

You can use both FNIS and Nemesis together, allowing you to get the best of both worlds. But keep in mind that whenever you install/uninstall any mod with animations in them, you will need to run both of these. Run FNIS first then Nemesis after.

**Checkpoint 2** - Run Skyrim, wait a minute, save and quit.

12. [JContainers](#) (R)

Needed for other mods. Get the right version for your game!

13. [PapyrusUtil](#) (R)

Same as above.

14. [Racemenu](#) (R)

Character customization upgrade. You also need this if you want to import other people's characters. Get the right version for your game!

15. [Skyrim Project Optimization](#)

Optimizes the game and improves performance in Skyrim's interiors

16. [Fuz Ro D-oh](#)

Allows dialogue for lines with no voice files, a very common requirement for a lot of mods.

17. [BodySlide and Outfit Studio](#) (R)

Tool for customizing body shape, and converting Skyrim clothes/armor to certain body types, needed for other mods and you will eventually use this tool.

18. [Either CBBE OR BHUNP Body Replacer](#) (R)

I am linking CBBE because that is what I use, if you want BHUNP just type it in nexus. Either one will work. Generally speaking, CBBE has a slightly curvier body whereas BHUNP has a thinner, more athletic body.

19. [XP32 Skeleton](#) (R)

This mod allows the body to be edited in ways it couldn't before, needed by other mods.

**Checkpoint 3** - Run Skyrim, type open up racemenu by pressing the “~” key and typing “showracemenu” just to make sure it works fine. I recommend you not to bother making a character until you're done installing your mods. Wait a bit, save and quit.

20. [FSMP](#) (R)

Makes your skin/hair have collusion. Needed for other mods. Make sure you install the correct version.

21. [Mfg Fix](#) (R)

Fixes and improves facial expressions, other mods may need this too.

## **Part 2 Beautify The Skyrim World**

Great, you've laid the foundation out. Now it's time to make the environment and lighting and the npc's look pretty. Note some of these mods are big and will take a bit to download.

How your Skyrim will look and feel mainly depends what ENB, World Textures, and Skin textures you decide to use. Mixing and swapping these around will give your Skyrim a unique feel and look. These are just my suggestions, so feel free to explore other places for these type of mods.

### **22. [Static Mesh Improvement Mod \(SMIM\)](#)**

Improves appearance of 3D models in Skyrim. Sometimes texture packs have a SMIM patch for compatibility so just watch out for that.

### **23. Texture and World overhauls!**

I primarily use [Noble Skyrim](#) and [Skyrim 2020 Parallax](#) in that order. But there's plenty of textures to choose from. Be wary with mods that increase grass and flora, as I find those drop FPS the most. But if your PC can handle it, go crazy. Some other packs you may want to look into.

There are SO many more on the nexus and a ton that you can find on youtube, you can spend literal days downloading and trying them out and deciding what should override what. I suggest just getting one or two packs and starting with that.

#### 24. NPC Overhauls!

For women I use [Botox for Skyrim](#), mainly because it's simple, plug and play, and very easy to use for my videos. However it is a must for me to mention the more popular [Bijin Warmaidens](#), [Bijin Wives](#), and [Bijin NPC's](#).

For males I use [Jampion NPC's](#) but [Male Npc Overhaul SE](#) is another good one. Either way make sure you get the files that say they are SOS light compatible if there are any (you will install later).

#### 25. Pretty Skin textures!

Turns out that Skyrim players like pretty women, and so they've made like 20 different Skin textures for women. No point in choosing more than one because one will overwrite the other.

If you don't know what to choose, Bijin skin is the most popular but feel free to experiment, there are a ton more on the nexus for you to check out.

Men don't get as much love as women when it comes down to aesthetics. The only skin texture for men that I know 100% works with SOS is [Tempered Skin For Males](#). I'm sure there are more out there, this is just the only one I've come across.

## 26. Atmospheric Overhauls and Enhanced Natural Beauty (ENB)

An ENB is essentially a collection of visual effects and graphical enchantments that make your game look next-gen when combined with your choice of textures.

Choose one ENB and one weather compatible with it. Can't decide? I can vouch for Silent horizons + Obsidian weathers

And be sure to grab [Realistic Water Two](#), it makes your water look very pretty.



**Checkpoint 4** - Run Skyrim just to make sure you can boot it up without crashing or having your computer explode. The environment should look beautiful, next we will make your character look beautiful.

### **Part 3 Making Your Character Look Good With Optional Cosmetics**

There are so many ways to make your Skyrim character look good. These are just some of the key ones of what I use but there are plenty out there to add more customization to your character, so of course these are all technically optional and interchangeable with any choice of mods you prefer.

27. [High Poly Head](#)

More polygons on your face = smoother face. If you decide to download presets of other people's characters you will likely need this.

28. [Brows](#) and [Kyoe's Bang'n Brows](#)

Adds, well, more brows.

Overlays/paints/makeup/Moles/Scars ETC.

29. [Community Overlays 1](#), [Community Overlays 2](#), [Community Overlays 3](#)

30. [Wolfpaint](#)

31. [Barbarian Bodypaints](#)

32. [Female Makeup Suite](#)

33. [Skin Feature Overlays](#)

34. [KS Hairdos - HDT SMP](#)

Adds Hair With Physics in Racemenu. There are a ton of hair mods out there, but this is the one I personally like the most. **(NOTE: that the HDT SMP requirement for this mod has been replaced by the FSMP that I have earlier in this guide, so don't download HDT SMP)**

35. [The Eyes Of Beauty](#)

Adds more really pretty eyes.

36. [Witcher 3 Eyes](#)

For both men and women

**Checkpoint 5** - Run Skyrim, wait a bit to let MCM register any menus if any. Save and quit.

#### **Part 4 Bodyslide, outfits, and physics**

3BBB and bodyslide and outfit studio can be a bit complex for beginners. Everything in this guide that involves bodyslide and physics will be covered in this part. Download all the mods and then **at the end I'll show how to build them all in bodyslide at the same time so that you only have to use the program once.**

Bodyslide presets change the body shape of both Player and NPC characters.

There are like a million bodyslide presets you can find on the nexus, so feel free to explore. But to give you a starting point, I made some of my own that you can find here:

37. [Luna's CBBE Bodyslide Presets](#)

The file linked is a pack containing 5 different bodyslide presets of different body types, their description is as follows:

**LL Petite:** Thinner/Smaller proportions, intended to be used for smaller characters

**LL Thicc:** Generous Proportions, I use this for the bulk of my characters and videos!

**LL Best Of Both:** An inbetween of LL Thicc and LL Petite

**LL Mommy:** Very generous proportions and larger belly.

**LL Sporty:** Thinish waist and largish breasts.

Download and select “add mod from file” in your mod manager.

38. [CBPC \(R\)](#)

This is a basic physics mod that works with 3BBB. It also adds a bulge to the belly when a penis enters a vagina, and applies physics to the armors that are not 3BBB compatible. Do note, that I normally disable this mod when I make my videos because I feel like the belly bulge is a little over the top.

39. [CBBE 3BBB \(R\)](#)

This is what makes breasts have great physics as well as vag collusion. When installing, make sure that you uncheck the box that makes them install their own Curvy body preset. For reference, I used the “Full option” and the Size C breast option when I installed this mod but feel free to experiment.

40. [BD's Armor and clothes replacer](#)

Basically makes vanilla armors show more skin for women, 3BBB compatible and we'll use bodyslide for it later. When installing click the option that allows you to install the Loose files, and uncheck the box that installs their prebuilt meshes. Be sure to also download the update file.

41. [Bikini Armors Remastered \(TAWOBA\)](#) And [Nimirim Collection](#)

Plenty of individual outfits/armors out there for women. I put these two packs just to get you started. Note that TAWOBA is 3BBB Compatible, and that Nimirim is not. So CBPC physics will kick in for the Nimirim outfits. Because of this, I normally use Nimirim for gameplay/screenshots and TAWOBA for sexual scenes. There are ways to craft them in game, but the easiest way to access them is via the QUI mod I linked earlier in the guide.

42. [Bad Dog Hoodies](#) and [Schlongs of Skyrim \(SOS\)](#)

Gives men meaty schlongs and changes the look depending on what race they are.

43. [Himbo](#)

Male body overhaul, install and later we'll apply it to characters via bodyslide.

44. [Tempered Skins](#) or [Bnp Male Skin](#)

Male skin textures compatible with SOS, if you have a pc that can handle it, I would recommend BnP male skin. Either way, make sure you get the files that are SOS full and Himbo compatible

Once you've downloaded all of those mods, go down to the very last few pages of this pdf (around page 37), I will show you how to install and apply Your CBBE preset, 3BBB physics, Tawoba, Niniirm, and HIMBO all at the same time! Or if you prefer, you can also see the instructions in the mod pages for each mod. The rest of my mods will not require the use of bodyslide and outfit studio so once you get that down you don't have to worry about using it.

## **Part 5 Sex Stuff Time**

You're finally here, the part where you're actually ready to turn Skyrim into a sexy game. You have up to 3 options for the core sex mods. Opensex, Flowergirls, or Sexlab. I will have a brief description of each, so that you can decide which to install based on your preferences.

If I had to oversimplify things:

**Flower girls** is like riding a bicycle, easy to pick up but rather limiting. If you want to primarily enjoy your modded Skyrim and have some romantic quests with sex involved and introduce sex into the world in the simplest form, choose flowergirls.

**Opensex** is like driving a car, and will suit most people but requires a little bit of knowledge. If you want to enjoy Skyrim with a sex-gameplay element, where you can control how fast you go, choose what positions etc then go with osex

**Sexlab** is like flying a helicopter, probably the most convoluted (but of course this guide will walk you through it), and will take you places that the other options can't. If you want

to enjoy Skyrim and have the most vile, niche fetishes and just have the largest pool of animation sets, then go with sexlab.

Again, this is a rather oversimplification. If I had to choose one, it would be Sexlab, since it has the most support and addons out of every sexframework out there. .

**“Can I have more than 1 core sex mod”** You *can*, it doesn't mean you should. I think you can run all 3 at the same time and maybe not run into anything game breaking, but I can't make promises once you start with the add-ons.

[Flower Girls](#) - One stop shop for immersive romance, If Bethesda had implemented sex/romance into vanilla Skyrim themselves this is what it would look like. Install and run FNIS/Nemesis, then you will have spells added to your inventory and you can start going around banging or getting banged. Or use the seduction system/pay people for their services. There are also a few addons you can consider to expand your experience:

- [Amorous Adventures](#) -romance/sex themed quests, its in the optional files of FG
- [Flower Girl NPC relationships](#) - Makes NPCs in relationships have sex on their own
- [FG Sperm textures](#)- adds better sperm textures to FG scenes
- [Secret Lives of NPCs](#) - adds 400+ sexual scenes around Skyrim to be discovered
- [High Poly NPC Overhaul for FG](#)- makes the flowergirls look way better

- [For more add ons](#) click on “Mods requiring this file” under the requirements to see all the mod addons that are dependent on flowergirls.

Opensex - Has an interactive element to it where they make you feel like it's a simulation and you get to control speeds/actions yourself, which is completely unique to this mod that you won't find in flower girls or sexlab. However, it is highly recommended that you use this mod with a keyboard that has a number pad as it makes it easier (you can also rebind keys in the MCM, but I find that my keyboard feels kinda crowded). This mod has some additional requirements unique to it

And now finally [Opensex](#)

Install everything above and run FNIS/Nemesis. If Ostim fails to install/initialize then you may need to do it on a new save.

Once installed, edit keybindings in the MCM if you do not have a number pad on your keyboard, otherwise go up to an NPC and press the up arrow on the keyboard to start a scene. You can use the numberpad to navigate the action menu and do as you wish.

This mod has a [whole other guide](#) to help you with troubleshooting in the case that you run into trouble, and of course read the forum posts on the mod.

Some add ons you may want to consider:

- [Amorous Adventures PLUS](#)- Romance/sex quests

- [Opensex Compatibility Patch](#) (and its requirements)- large animation pack expansion
- [Immersive Wenches](#) - Adds wenches
- [Oprivity](#) - stop having sex in public
- [Anim Packs](#) - additional animation packs

Sexlab- has the most amount of animations and add ons that I've seen by sheer number, as well as the most fetishy things. You are going to need several mods (if you don't want creature sex then you can skip the creature mods):

- [Sex Lab Framework](#)- The foundation and groundwork for sex in Skyrim. Make sure your mother is not in the room when you install this.
- [Sexlab Aroused Redux](#) Implements an arousal system for sexlab, this is needed for creature framework if you want it.
- [Creature Framework](#)- The foundation and groundwork for creature sex in Skyrim. Make sure the FBI is not in the room when you install this.
- [SexLab Animation Loader 1.6 \(SLAL\)](#) - This will be in the MCM in the Skyrim pause menu. **In order for animations to work you will have to both: update FNIS/Nemesis AND register them in the SLAL tab in MCM everytime you install an animation pack.** Adds another menu in MCM that you need to access to register animations from animation packs you will download later.
- [More Nasty Critters and Hentai Creatures \(Grab both files\)](#)- Adds the creatures and animals that you can have sex with make sure you grab both files!
- [Matchmaker](#)- Lets you start scenes without an RP element



- [Baka ABC \(Animated Beast Cocks\)](#)- Make sure this overwrites any other animal schlong mod (more nasty critters). This allows animations on creature peepees.
- Animation packs to get you started: [Anubs](#), [Billyy](#), [Sir Nibbles](#)

You're in the homestretch at this point. These are the next steps. Note, that if some stuff doesn't appear in the MCM you will have to try it on a fresh save.

- Run FNIS (if you have it for creatures)
- Run Nemesis.
- Go in game and wait a few minutes for the MCM to register any new mods
- Go to the sexlab MCM and press the "Install" option. Close all menus and wait in game until you get a notification at the top left of your screen saying that it is ready.
- Go to the SL Anim Loader MCM and you will see an option to "enable all animations" and select it. This could take a few minutes, it's normal. Then press the "register all animations" option. Depending on how many packs you installed this can take like 10 whole minutes. Just don't tab out or close the menu until you get the confirmation message that it worked.
- Go to the mass matchmaker MCM > Config > Check the Manual Select Mode option.
- Go to your spells and equip and use the "Mass matchmaker Gangbang self" spell and select an NPC (your game will be kinda wonky and maybe even lag a bit

before the animation starts, this is normal). This is just to test that sex animations are working.

If you also wanted creature sex then

- go to the sexlab MCM and find the “allow creature animations” option and select it.
- go to the hentai creatures tab in MCM and select “dump spells on you”.
- If you only want the creature to have sex with you then you can toggle those options in the hentai creature MCM (otherwise, sometimes when you try to mate it may wonder off and have sex with a nearby NPC instead of you, unless you want that).
- Go to your conjuration spells and summon your choice of creature, press the talk button on it and select mate.
- If you want it to mate with a specific character that is NOT your player character, you have to use the matchmaker spells from the matchmaker mod. I recommend you go to the matchmaker MCM and enable the manual selection option so that you specifically choose who has sex with who.

At some point I recommend you take a deepdive in your MCM and change things to your liking.

Here are some addons for sexlab (some may work with the other sex frameworks).

Please! Be careful when downloading some of these and just make sure that they are

up to date with whatever Skyrim version you are running. **You are now entering what I call the wild west of Skyrim!**

- [Amorous Adventures Plus](#) - sex/romance themed mods
- [Animal Mansion](#) - sex quests with creatures
- [Immersive Wenches](#) - adds wenches
- [Slave Girls](#) - Slave houses, caravans, dungeons, etc throughout Skyrim
- [Blush When Aroused](#) - makes your character blush when aroused
- [Sexlab Privacy](#) - You and your partner will find a private place before having sex, just for the immersion
- [Sexlab Solutions](#) -Use sex as a solution to many things in Skyrim (avoid tolls, jail etc.)
- [Sexlab Adventures](#) - Public nudity/sex is a crime, chance of a sexual encounter while you are asleep, and other sex-related immersion stuff

### **Common Issues section**

Just a small section dedicated to trouble shooting some common issues that people have told me that have occurred in their game.

If you're having issues and something isn't working try downloading [loot](#)

This will organize your load order. I hear it doesn't work well with vortex though. Why? I have no idea, I don't use vortex.

### **Do your creatures have erectile dysfunction?**

This is a very common issue and I have no idea what causes it but there is a fix.

Download and install [More creatures](#)

Then download and install [More nasty critters always erect](#)

Then load the game and test it out, if it's still wonky or not working, try disabling SOS.

### **The Werewolf/Werebear Schlongs are tripping out and not working properly**

Not entirely sure what causes this, because I think SOS and ABC are supposed to be compatible with each other, but I found out that disabling SOS fixes the issue.

### **How do I start a threesome or fourway?**

Use the spell “Mass Matchmaker Gangbang Self” and a gangbang should start with the actors around you, I HIGHLY recommend going through the MCM for Match Maker and setting the “Manual selection mode” on so that you can choose your actors. Same goes for animals. Only works if you have a valid animation for the actors you selected. For example, if you selected female, male, then press end a threeway will occur with the female, male, and your player character. If you select female, male, horse, dog, skeever, then press end probably nothing will play because you don't have an animation that involves all those actors. Sometimes, even when you have the manual select option, all the NPCs in the room won't show up in the menu. Pretty sure this is just Skyrim being Skyrim. Keep trying, or if you really want, you can spawn your actors indoors and try that. That's what I typically do with my vids.

### **My men have a texture mismatch at the seam of the neck**

If you are using my set of mods for men, make sure that they are installed in the order presented in the guide otherwise it will not work. If you are using a different male skin setup, then try reinstalling the mod and making sure it overwrites everything it needs to.

### **My character/creature is standing still and not doing anything during sex/dry humping the air and you cannot cancel the animation or end it.**

Assuming you download all the required mods for sexlab make sure you

- Ran FNIS and/or Nemesis.
- Registered all your sex animations in SLAL

If that doesn't work, there are few other things you can do. Download [Sexlab Tools For SE](#) and try setting up a hotkey in the MCM for changing animation sets and one for realigning actors, and try them during the animation when it plays. There are a lot of things that can mess with sex animations. Uneven ground, playing animations with the wrong actors (using a dog and female animation while using a male and female for the scene) and a ton of other stuff.

For some large creatures like horses and dragons, sometimes what will happen is that the creature walks towards my character for a long time, and then when the animation starts they just idle in place, and I am unable to cancel it or change animations using SL tools. When this happens I force quit the game, then reboot and try again, only this time I type in "tai" and "tcai" in the console, this disables NPC ai, and stops any NPC from moving on their own. I find it helps with starting the animation.

### **If your body disappears except for the arms and head during an animation**

Go to sexlab in MCM and make sure "equip nude suit" option is not checked.

### **If your characters and npcs are not aligned well during an animation**

Things like high heels or some leg armors that make you taller can unalign the actors in the animation so be sure to remove them or sometimes they do that for no reason at all so if at any time if they are unaligned then stop the animation, go to MCM-> Sexlab-> player hotkeys and set up a hotkey for "realign actors". Then whenever they do that again, hit the hotkey. Animations are selected at random, so if you downloaded a pack that has a furniture animation, it may play that animation even when the furniture is not

present. As a result, your actors could be banging on top of a table that isn't there and it would look weird. For that I recommend you use SE SL tools.

### **If your actors merge together and do a dry humping animation instead of a scene**

Read above. You may need SE SL Tools

### **Lip sync during scenes doesn't work or is wonky**

Yep there is a fix for that [here!](#)

### **Creature Framework doesn't show up in the MCM or won't stop initializing**

Yeah, that happens. To be honest you don't really need it in the MCM. But if you really want it, you'll need to start a new save and it should configure just fine and show up in the MCM. Same if it won't stop initializing.

### **Female takes the male position or vice versa**

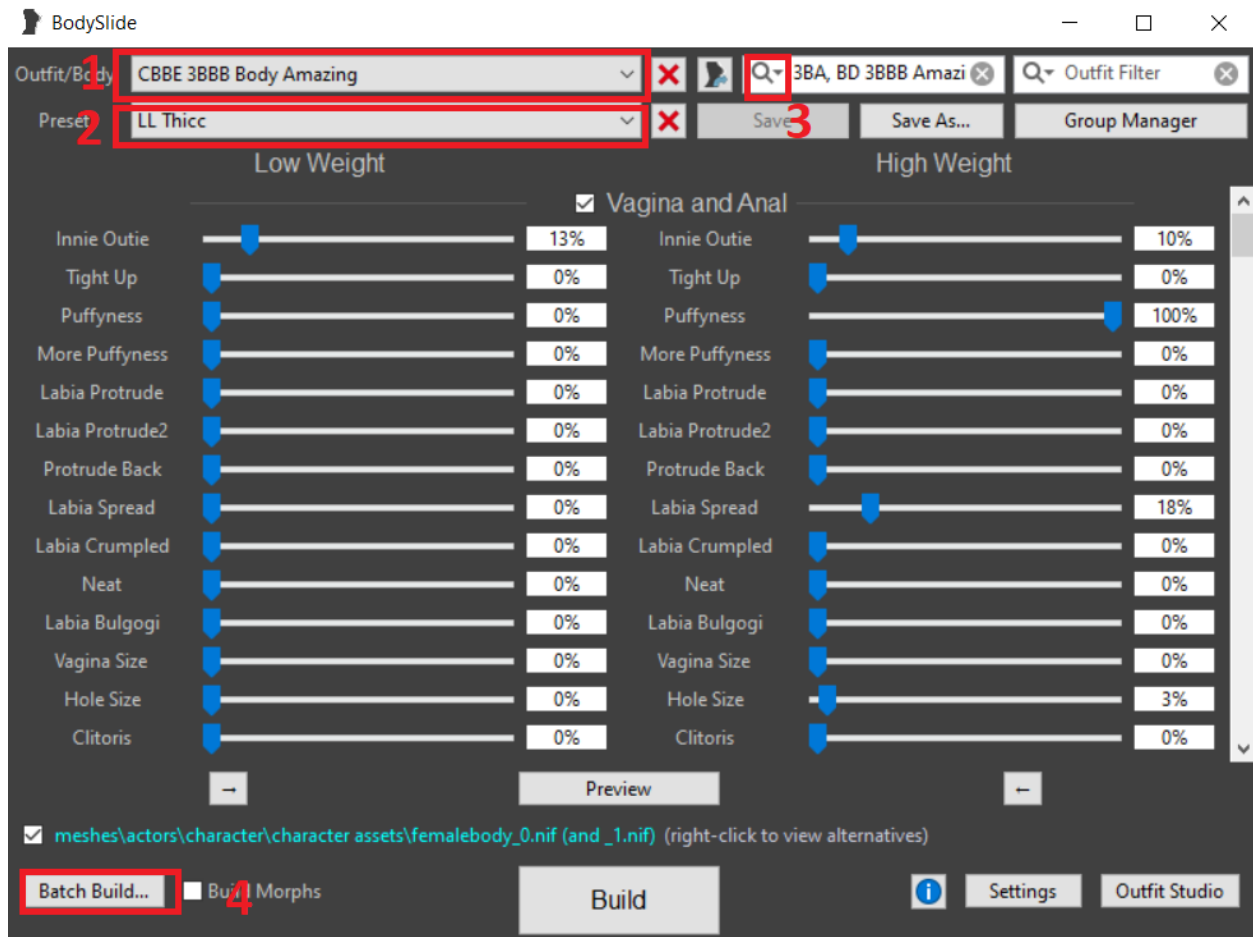
You can toggle a hotkey to swap actor roles in the sexlab MCM when that happens.

### **Don't see your issue here?**

You're gonna have to do your own troubleshooting and research. Checking out the forum posts for the mods having issues is a good way to start as it's possible that someone else had the same issue as you.

## Bodyslide and outfit studio tutorial

This is a step by step guide on how to use bodyslide to actually apply your CBBE preset and physics to your female NPCs and character, Making TAWOBA and Ninirim outfits morph to your CBBE preset, and applying your HIMBO preset to your NPCs and character.



1. Open the bodyslide program, either through the data folder where you installed it in, or through your mod manager, then on the Outfit/Body Box, click on it and select "CBBE 3BBB Body Amazing" from the drop down.
2. In the Preset box, select your downloaded preset from the dropdown box. If you are using one that I made it will show up here, click on the one you want your

female player character to have, or NPCs if you're not playing a female character.

3. In the top right, click on the little magnifying glass icon → Choose groups → checkmark the following items:
  - 3BA
  - BD 3BBB Amazing
  - CBBE
  - CBBE Bodies
  - CBBE Vanilla Outfits
  - KS Hairdos SMP- Collusions (CBBE)
  - TAWOBA Remastered [3BA]
  - [Sunjeong] Ninirim Collection Group
4. In the bottom left, click on “batch build” and build. It might take a while because you are building about 1000 outfits.
5. Congrats!

What you succeeded in doing this part is: Applied your CBBE preset to all women, applied physics to the CBBE preset, and built the outfits to the said preset.

Now for men

On the box with the magnifying glass, click on the little X to clear the groups.



1. For the outfit/body box select “ [HIMBO Body- SOS]” from the drop down box
2. For the preset box, select your preferred preset (if you want to see what they look like you can select one and click on the preview box above the build button) in my case I chose HIMBO Mike.
3. Click on the magnifying glass and checkmark “Himbo body for SOS Physics”
4. Make sure the box above batch build is checked, then click on batch build!

You're done! What you accomplished was applying the male body preset to male characters and NPCs and made sure it worked with schlongs
