

LPSV-01 Open License Certificate
Asset: FREZYA - "FURTIVA"
Issuer: Lokidio Lab
Standard: LPSV-01 Open - Creator-Focused
Music Asset License

Note: This document defines the legal and technical terms of use.

1. Purpose

FURTIVA is a classified audio asset, a high-fidelity, clearance-ready track released under the LPSV-01 Open commercial, royalty-free license, with transparent rights, verifiable licensing and protocol metadata designed to reduce Content ID friction and support reliable commercial reuse across platforms.

This asset is provided as a clearance-ready technical file, optimized for reliable commercial reuse in both interactive and linear environments.

LPSV-01 Open is a fully commercial, royalty-free music license designed for the creator economy. It turns selected music tracks into predictable, verifiable audio assets which can be safely integrated into long-term projects without subscription lock-in or revenue-sharing obligations.

This certificate applies specifically to the asset:

- Title: "FURTIVA"
- Artist: FREZYA (virtual vocalist)
- Produced by: Lokidio Lab

2. Eligible Users - Who This License Is For

Under LPSV-01 Open, the following are considered eligible Creators:

- Streamers and VTubers
(Twitch, YouTube, Kick, Facebook Gaming, RP servers, etc.)
 - Film, TV and streaming productions
(feature films, series, documentaries, streaming originals)
 - Game developers
(indie, AA, prototypes, tools, vertical slices, interactive experiences)
 - Trailer, promo and branded content teams
(launch trailers, promos, sizzle reels, marketing and brand videos)
 - Online creators
(YouTube, TikTok, Instagram, Shorts, Reels and similar platforms)
- All of the above are collectively referred to as "Creators" in this document.

3. Rights Granted - What You May Do

Subject to compliance with the full license terms, LPSV-01 Open grants Creators the right to:

(1) Use the Track in commercial and non-commercial projects, including but not limited to:

- livestreams and VOD content
- films, series, documentaries and streaming originals
- game projects, prototypes and interactive experiences
- trailers, promos, branded content and social media video

(2) Monetize their projects that include the Track, including:

- advertising revenue, subscriptions, sponsorships and tips
- direct sales, rentals or licensing of the final project
- platform revenue-sharing schemes

(3) Host, stream, upload and archive projects containing the Track on major online platforms (e.g. YouTube, Twitch and similar services), provided that the Creator complies with both platform policies and this license and does not present the Track itself as a standalone release under their own artist identity.

Creators may use FURTIVA in whole or in part, including reasonable edits, cuts and loops, as long as the Track remains clearly recognizable and is not marketed as a new standalone release.

4. What "Royalty-Free" Means Under LPSV-01 Open

When LPSV-01 Open describes the Track as "royalty-free", it means:

- Creators do not pay ongoing royalties or usage fees per view, per stream or per download.
- Creators do not pay recurring subscription fees in order to keep their rights active.
- Creators do not owe revenue share from their project's income to the rights holder, for uses covered by this license.

The rights holder retains ownership of the Track and all associated intellectual property. Creators are granted a license to use the Track under the terms of LPSV-01 Open; they do not acquire ownership of the Track itself.

5. Verification & Protocol Metadata

The LPSV protocol ensures verifiable licensing and includes protocol metadata intended to minimize copyright conflicts and support automated or semi-automated clearance workflows where possible. This metadata framework is designed to make the Track more predictable and traceable in professional environments, including streaming platforms, content networks and interactive media pipelines. Protocol metadata is provided as part of the release package (certificate + licence ID + issuer contact), intended to support practical clearance workflows.

6. DMCA-Resilient Design

LPSV-01 Open is engineered to be DMCA-resilient:

- The rights holder will not intentionally issue DMCA takedown notices or similar claims against Creators who use the Track in good faith and in compliance with this license.
- The Track is configured to minimize the risk of automated Content ID conflicts wherever reasonably possible.
- If a platform or network requests proof that the Creator has the right to use the Track, this certificate and license text can be presented as evidence of permission.

This license is not a guarantee that no third party will ever file a bad-faith claim or that platforms will never make mistakes, but it is a clear, creator-friendly framework that defines your rights and is built to reduce claim friction in practice.

7. Key Restrictions (Plain Language)

Under LPSV-01 Open, Creators may not:

- claim ownership of the Track itself (for example, by uploading it as their own song, library track or "original soundtrack")
- re-sell or re-distribute the Track as part of a competing music library, "royalty-free pack" or similar standalone music product
- register the Track, or any substantially identical copy, in Content ID or similar systems as if they were the rights holder - use the Track in ways that are illegal or that clearly violate platform policies

These restrictions are intended to protect the integrity of the Track and the rights holder, while still giving Creators broad freedom to use FURTIVA inside their projects.

8. Attribution (Credit)

Where reasonably possible, Creators are requested to provide clear credit for the Track in their project. A suitable form of credit is, for example:

Music: FURTIVA - FREZYA (LPSV-01 Open, Lokidio Lab)

In long-form content (such as films, series, games), this credit should appear in the end credits or an equivalent credits section. In online content (such as streams and videos), this credit should appear in the description, shownotes or an on-screen overlay where feasible.

9. Disclaimer & Issuer

This document serves as the official LPSV-01 Open license for the track "FURTIVA" by FREZYA, issued by Lokidio Lab.

It is intended as a clear and human-readable statement of the rights granted and restrictions applied under this license. If Lokidio Lab publishes an updated or extended legal license for this Track in the future, that later version will take precedence from its date of publication for new uses, but existing good-faith uses made under this document will remain valid.
