9 am

Sophie is preparing food with Ms. Rivera

Leo is lining up digits on a carpet (1-9), then moves on to bigger numbers

Julian is snacking and watching the aquarium

Ethan and Silas have bead chains laid out on multiple mats. One is looking at a chart and then says $9+9=17$. Oliver is watching them. They are also naming large numbers, like 343

Ms. Maya is setting up a work with larger numbers

Sophie asks where to put dirty dishes

Silas and Ethan are now saying that $9+8=17$

Sophie is getting a snack. They have aprons. Sophie tells Julian not to take all of the snack, Julian says he knows and they start getting into an argument. Ms. Rivera asks Sophie, "Are you getting frustrated?" Julian says he's frustrated too because he already knows

Caleb is working on retrieving quantities or deciding which work to do.

Leo asks whether something is a 6 or 9, and Ms. Maya answers that it depends on whether the tail is up or down.

Ms. Rivera asks Silas and Ethan how many of these makes a big cube. She is observing and sometimes intervening.

Julian is getting water and Sophie asks where he is sitting

Oliver comments on Caleb's hat having a lot of colors

Silas and Ethan are looking at a cube and beads hanging. Ms. Maya suggests Caleb ask them about a number, and Ethan replies that 3 tens is 30

Leo is putting more cards in order

Caleb is getting individual beads, tens, hundreds, and thousands to make 1234. After getting the beads, Ms. Maya asks about a book he likes. Caleb talks about an art project he did, and Ms. Maya shares how she enjoys painting. They check in on Leo's assembly of numbers.

Sophie asks Julian are talking about yummy peanut butter, and about their imaginary cats.

Silas and Ethan go get water.

Ms. Rivera is supervising Oliver on another work?

Caleb is talking about a favorite cartoon character, and Ms. Maya says she doesn't know much about superheroes. She notes to Caleb that he was touching his nose and asks him to go wash his hands. He goes towards the bathroom but gets distracted watching Silas and Ethan; Ms.

Maya reminds him to go wash hands.

Leo is now counting a quantity of beads

Sophie and Julian seem to have a semi-argument about what they should tell their parents, and Ms. Rivera reminds them that their parents would love to hear anything they want to say about their time at school. Julian asks Sophie to believe him about something.

Silas and Ethan ask Ms. Maya, what is the total?

Ms. Maya reviews quantity that Caleb assembled

Julian and Sophie talk about sounds that cats make

Silas and Ethan are taking chains off board. I think now they are returned. And they rolled up mats

Ms. Maya asks Leo to pick up tray instead of pushing it on the ground

Leo and Caleb are adding their quantities. Leo returns one in unit tray as he got an extra. Ms.

Maya acknowledges that sometimes we get an extra while counting

9:30 am

Oliver is getting a snack and greets Sophie and Julian

Ms. Rivera is cleaning up with Silas and Ethan

Leo is asked to exchange unit beads

Ms. Maya calms down Leo and Caleb who are impatient, e.g. Caleb is upset that beads spilled and they get labels for numbers

Silas is now cleaning up little number tabs

Ms. Rivera brings Oliver to practical works table

Julian and Sophie wear aprons on their heads and pretend it's hair. They are dancing and singing. Julian starts cleaning up his snack spot

Silas asks Leo and Caleb what they're doing

Ms. Maya asks what Caleb will exchange 10 tens for

Sophie puts snack away

Julian gets orange juicing tray from practical works

Oliver struggles with his apron and Ms. Rivera helps, then snacks

Sophie says she needs to use the restroom, to Julian. Julian says he needs to as well. Ms.

Maya suggests he go; Julian says he doesn't actually need to go. Ms. Maya tells Julian this is confusing to say

Silas and Ethan are putting tags near bead strings, then they are rolling up mats and cleaning up.

Oliver goes to the bathroom as well, he talks to Sophie

Julian is eating the orange from his work and asks Ms. Rivera for another orange.

Caleb is pressing against Ms. Maya's body, and Ms. Maya reminds him to ask if he wants a hug.

He does ask and Ms. Maya gives him a hug

Leo and Caleb are asked what they want their story to be about. Ms. Maya reminds them about sitting often. The story is something like "the space explorers found 1234 moon rocks and the astronauts found 3234 moon rocks, how many moon rocks total did they find?"

Silas and Ethan are going to the bathroom together

Ms. Maya asks Leo and Caleb if they want to play addition again

Julian has been sitting near Leo's mat while doing orange juicing, and Leo is upset because some of his numbers have been moved. Julian is upset and argues that he did not move the numbers. Ms. Maya notes the possibility that this is an accident.

Ms. Maya suggests to Sophie to count stones and puts previous Caleb's counting work away. Sophie gets out 7 and retrieves 5 stones, asks Ms. Rivera if this is correct. Ms. Rivera helps her get to 7 stones

Leo wants a story about a train. Ms. Maya says she may also take a turn deciding the story. Julian is done orange juicing and cleans up. Then he gets a tea set practical work and gets water from the sink.

Sophie asks Julian if she got 1 stone and he corrects her

Caleb says to Ms. Maya, I want to be a teacher. Ms. Maya asks why? Caleb says, because I want to help people learn.

Sophie rolls up her counting map. Ms. Maya notes to Julian that he seems interested in counting, but Julian says he was just helping Sophie

Sophie takes down a photo in a frame and then puts it back up.

Leo notes that the classroom plant is growing. Then he talks about different types of leaves.

Julian says that trees can live to be very old. He counts how high he can count, from 1-10.

Sophie says to Ms. Rivera she also has pictures at home

10 am

Caleb is laying on Leo's lap while counting. Ms. Maya asks if he needs a body stretch. Leo says he is okay with it.

Sophie is getting multiple counting rods while working with Ms. Rivera

Ms. Maya gets a green body sock for Caleb to calm his body. She also offers Caleb the quiet cube in the corner and asks him to return when he's ready

Julian observes Leo and Caleb

Ms. Rivera helps Silas with toilet paper in the bathroom

Leo gets weather while Caleb is in the corner. Ms. Maya waits at the math work

Ms. Maya tells Leo that the bathroom is a private area while others are in it, i.e. to discourage talking to kids in bathroom

Julian smells tea bag

Silas and Ethan exit bathroom and they choose slicing works (banana, egg)

Ms. Maya asks Leo to review his numbers

Julian is done with tea and asks Ms. Maya if he should pour it in to sink, then cleans up

Caleb returns green body sock to the teacher's table

Caleb is playing with his pants and Ms. Maya tries to return his attention to math work

Julian walks around the classroom. Then returns to his station with a box and paper. He offers

Ms. Rivera a piece of paper and puts it on the teachers' desk

Ms. Maya stops counting work and notes that attention has diminished, but Leo and Caleb want to keep going

Oliver goes to see Silas and Ethan

Liam is arriving late and Ms. Maya lets him in

Julian gets out string and makes a kite

Leo and Caleb are punching themselves and falling over

Ms. Maya lets Leo know that rolling around means they aren't ready to play addition and suggests they can show her they are ready to play

Sophie returns number sticks
