can join them in picking up litter along the coast, or simply spread the word

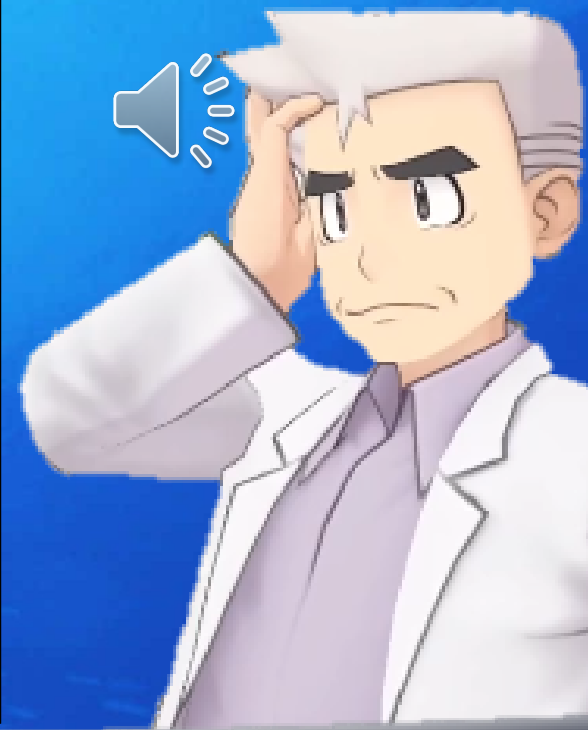

Glue white teeth on one side of head.

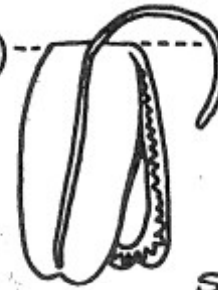

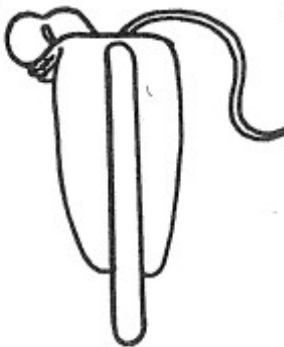
Glue red mouth on top of teeth.

③



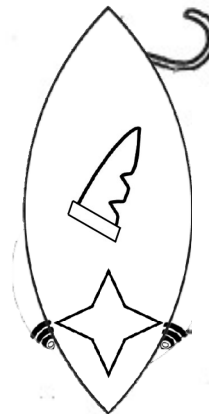
Fold head in half on dotted line. Glue $\frac{1}{2}$ of string on one side of folded head, leaving the other half free at the top.
